

HOUSING QUESTIONNAIRE

Montserrat College of Art offers apartment style living within walking distance of all academic buildings, other residence halls, and downtown Beverly. Our students enjoy the independence of apartment style residence halls, and benefit from trained Resident Assistants who help to support community development, safety, and security on-campus. Most housing is on a shared basis with two students per bedroom; however there are some triple and single rooms on campus. The number of students in each apartment varies depending on the size of the unit with some apartments housing only three students and others housing as many as eleven. All apartments feature a common living space, a bathroom and a kitchen including a refrigerator and stove.

A non-refundable housing deposit is required to secure a room in student housing.

It is extremely helpful for both you and for Campus Life staff to have this information when they determine housing placement. If you do not return this form but have made the housing deposit, you will still receive a housing assignment.
