

Example of a Great Reminder Email for Life Group

Below is an example email that Mike and Debb sent to their Life Group for an upcoming meeting. It does several things really well:

- 1) It's enthusiastic. After reading the email it makes me want to come to group!
- 2) They give a rough idea of what they'll be doing at group.
- 3) They preview the LifeLine questions they will be discussing. Paragraphs #2 and #3 are from the LifeLine even though it doesn't feel like they were just copied and pasted.
- 4) They remind people of the logistics: time & who has snacks.
- 5) They send a similar message like this every week. They also include those that weren't there last week or haven't attended for several weeks to keep them in the loop.
