All notes **MUST** be handwritten and you can use any notes on readings quizzes in class. Use the template to take notes over your reading.

1 – Identify the chapter and the date

~ This is important for you to keep your notes organized

2 – “Notes” column

~ Take meaningful and legible notes

~ Use abbreviations

~ Use spaces to show division between ideas, concepts, or sections

3 – “Main Ideas” column

~ Summarize the main ideas

~ List key words or phrases, you can also draw pictures in this column

~ Use this column as a quick study guide

4 – “Summary” section

~ Use this to provide a concise summary of what you read

~ This section will serve as a quick study guide
