Just a reminder...

1. A wedding is not a place for preschoolers, for any reason. An active child is a normal child and God didn't design them to be still through a formal ceremony. A nursery should be provided, just in case anyone brings a preschooler.
2. If you plan to have your wedding filmed - Persons need to dress appropriately for the wedding. Males should wear white shirts with tie and dark coat. Females should dress appropriately according to the season and time of wedding.
3. No photographs are to be taken during the wedding ceremony except by permission of the pastor and by a professional photographer. The lights and sounds of picture taking are a major distraction from you, your mate and the wedding.
