

Report of Creative Writing [English]

Creative Writing is a Composition of any type of Writing of any time primarily in the service of Such needs as the need for keeping records of significant experience , the need for sharing Experience with the interest group and the need for free individual expression which contributes to mental and physical health . Creative Writing is any writing that goes outside the bounds of the normal professional, academic or technical forms of literature, character development & the use of literary tropes. Both fictional and Non-fictional works fall into this category including novels, biographies, short stories and poems. Creative Writing can technically be considered and writing of the original composition.

In our school , English Creative Writing was starting on 16th August 2013 .Mr. G,S.Dhaliwal (PGT ENGLISH) from Sainik school (Kapurthala) was invited for giving speech and to conduct the program . On that day, he gave introduction of creative writing, poem writing and Shakespeare creative writing.

It was an interactive session .students asked number of questions and resources person satisfied them with answer .Besides this he pieces of creative writing and motivated the students to write something like riddle, poems etc. He explained in details that nature is the best teacher, friend, guide and philosopher.

Then he came on 20th August and delivered a speech for writing speeches, short stories and our contribution to school magazine. He explained that writing a speech is a very challenging task for anyone because it involves a wide range of vocabulary, some research and a lot of organizational abilities. He also explained that a speech begins with a formal address .Then he gave his explanation about story writing. He explains that one of the best ways to create a story is to base it upon real life occurrences .Our experiences allow us to create settings and characters that seem real. We should be aware about the theme, setting, plot and characterization. Next session was on 22nd August

.He conducted a lecture on 'Our Contribution to the schools magazine'. On 27th August, he gave explanation on the Article Writing and poster Making He explained that Article Writing involves a high degree of creativity, wide knowledge about the subject and some research .One has to keep in mind the target readers, the purpose of writing an article, as well as on appropriate style. It requires a lot of correction and revision before it can be called a well – written piece. On 29th of August, he read aloud letter of Abraham Lincoln to his son's housemaster.

English is a difficult language and students hesitate to adopt it because of their poor command on vocabulary. Deep in their minds they feel that they need bombastic words to express themselves. The resource person helped students shed this inhibition regarding English and various tips for improving vocabulary and understanding the text were given to students.

Students took an active part in the creative writing workshop. Many students wrote poems about various topics, budding writers and poets were very enthusiastic and put a lot of efforts and energy in creating short poems, articles, riddles, jokes etc. some of them collected thoughts of great personalities.

31th August 2013 was the closing day of the above said workshop. Works of young creators were artistically exhibited in the M.P hall. Whole school visited this exhibition and appreciated the works.
