

Multimedia Project Assignment Sheet

Work with your group to create a multimedia project based on the following guidelines:

1. Create a multimedia work that you can present to the class. The work can be on a topic and in a format of your choice, but all group members must agree on both the topic and format.
2. Include at least two of the following forms of media: images, video, sound, animation, text, graphics.
3. Be sure that your presentation lasts between 1 and 5 minutes.
4. Be sure that you can publish your work in digital form without breaking copyright law.

To help you meet the criteria, you will be given information about multimedia tools and copyright. Your final project will be assessed on:

Achievement of the purpose you state in the planning stage	<i>20 points</i>

Compliance of all resources used with U.S. copyright law	<i>10 points</i>
Evidence of group effort	<i>20 points</i>
