When you apply to Boston University, you will need to submit the following requirements. Please use this checklist to stay on track:

- ☐ College/University Transcript(s)
- ☐ Transfer College Report
- ☐ Course Syllabi
- ☐ Secondary School Records, including your graduation certificate/diploma and any external exam results such as IGCSEs, if applicable
- ☐ Instructor Evaluation
- ☐ Essays
- ☐ English Proficiency Testing Results
- ☐ Documentation of Financial Support
- ☐ Passport Photocopy
- ☐ Additional Supporting Credentials such as portfolios, if applicable to the program you're applying to. Please refer to bu.edu/admissions/apply/international-transfer/application-instructions for more information about these.

The deadline for January admission is **November 1**.

The deadline for September admission is **March 1**.
