

**Proposal for Evening Family Event

Event: Hour of Code Family Event

Location: CHS Computer Labs; Rooms 513 and 222

Dates: Thursday, January 12 2017 (Grade 3)
Tuesday, January 17, 2017 (Grade 4)
Thursday, January 19, 2017 (Grade 5)

Times: One session per night for grades 4 and 5 from 6:00-7:00pm
Two sessions for grade 3 from 6:00-7:00 and 7:15-8:15

Participants: 20 students per session (parents are invited to attend with their child)

Facilitators: Tim Wojciechowski and Dana Teague

Objective: The Hour of Code is a global movement created by Computer Science Education Week and Code.org to reach tens of millions of students in 180+ countries to promote a one-hour introduction to computer science and computer programming. Harker's Hour of Code night will afford students the opportunity to experience hands on computer coding to spark interest in careers in the computer field.
