Camper Behavior Contract

Campers are expected to abide by certain rules at Atlantic Burn Camp. They are as follows:

- 1. No abusive or foul language. This includes all “four-letter words,” and name-calling.**
- 2. No smoking, alcohol, drugs or weapons at camp.**
- 3. You will learn the rules when you get to camp.**
- 4. After curfew, campers must stay in their cabins.**
- 5. Smoke detectors and fire extinguishers in cabins are not to be played with.**
- 6. Cabin Leaders are your “parents” and “teachers” while you are at camp. What they say goes.**
- 7. You must stay with your cabin group at all times. No “sneaking off.”**
- 8. No hitting, shoving, pinching, scratching, biting, etc.**

If your cabin leaders feel that you are breaking your camper contract, you will be given a chance to correct your behavior. If you don't, we will call your parents to come and get you. Campers who have to be sent home because they can't behave will not be invited back.

I have read this contract with my parents/guardians and I understand what it means. I promise to obey the rules and I understand that if I don't, I might be sent home and my attendance in future years at Atlantic Burn Camp will be in jeopardy.
