

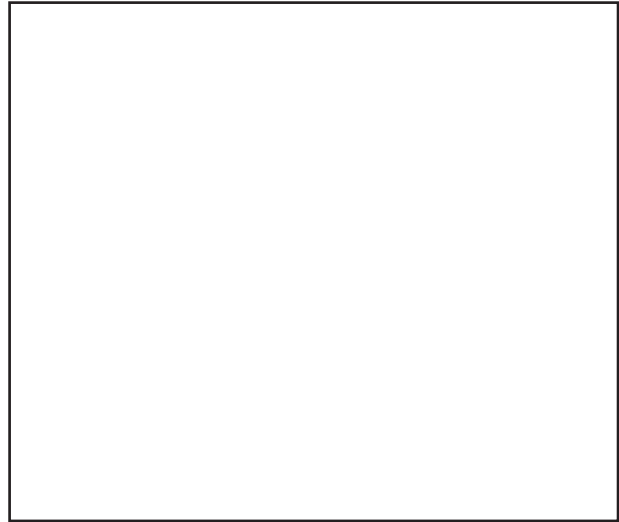
Prepositions and Prepositional Phrases



A **preposition** is a word that shows the relationship between a noun or a pronoun and another word in the sentence.
