



## After School Tutoring Contract

The purpose of tutoring is to provide Jefferson West Middle School students the opportunity for additional help with school work. Students who are failing a class, are behind or need another perspective on problems are welcome to attend tutoring. Tutoring will be offered from 3:30-4:30 p.m. on days posted in the announcements.

Students will not be allowed to attend tutoring unless they have a signed tutoring contract on file in the Library. Students are expected to attend tutoring for the entire hour. If they complete their work before tutoring is over, they will be given enrichment activities utilizing the VPL computer program.

If a student becomes disruptive, the parent or guardian will be contacted and required to remove the disruptive student. The student will then not be allowed to return for tutoring help for two consecutive sessions. If the same student is asked to leave a second time, they will not be allowed to attend tutoring for the rest of that quarter of school. A third offense will make the student ineligible to receive tutoring assistance the remainder of the year.

My student and I have read and understand the conditions of this contract. We agree to abide by the dismissal policies outlined above in the case of disruption.
