

SEEN BUT NOT HEARD

TUESDAY 28TH JANUARY 2015

As the school bell rang at Hill Hodge Primary School yesterday morning, several surprised witnesses claim to have seen children stopping and simultaneously pointing towards the sky.

This strange event was most unusual for the quiet primary school, which is located in Oak Meadow. Mr Smith, a teacher at Hill Hodge Primary School, maintained that four of the children in his class fell silent and stood in a trance-like state, raising their fingers to the ceiling. What they were pointing at cannot yet be confirmed.

Another teacher at the school, Mrs Cook, informed us that similar events occurred in her classroom: "It was the strangest moment – Mrs Johnson fell to the floor in shock and it took several minutes to revive her!

Initially we were led to believe that Oak Meadow was the only area to be affected by these strange

happenings. However, it can be confirmed that similar events were witnessed across the country, including one case in Northern Ireland.

The events were brief in all cases, lasting between 2 and 3 minutes. Mr Granger stated that children appeared to have no recollection of the event, and quickly returned to normal. However Miss Fret, who has been the head teacher at Hill Hodge for seven years, noticed that, in their tests this morning, most children achieved on average 3 more marks than usual.

This bizarre and unusual case is still under investigation and witnesses are still being called for evidence.
