

HOMONYMS, HOMOPHONES, AND HOMOGRAPHS

Hint: Homo- means "same!"

"-NYM" MEANS
"NAME."

e.g.,
Amber (girl's name)/
amber (fossilized resin)



ARE WORDS THAT ARE
PRONOUNCED THE SAME
AND MAY BE SPELLED THE
SAME OR DIFFERENTLY BUT
DIFFER IN MEANING.

"-PHONE" MEANS
"SOUND."

e.g.,
hear (receive sound)/
here (in place)



ARE WORDS
THAT ARE
PRONOUNCED
THE SAME BUT
ARE SPELLED
DIFFERENTLY
AND DIFFER IN
MEANING.

"-GRAPH" MEANS
"WRITING."

e.g.,
lead (graphite)/
lead (guide)



ARE WORDS THAT ARE
SPELLED THE SAME
BUT ARE NOT
PRONOUNCED THE
SAME AND DIFFER IN
MEANING.
