

Report Writing

WALT: classify, describe, locate and present the aspects of an animal.

Success Criteria: to present a factual report that describes all the information about an animal using the report writing framework.

Report Framework

Title - the title is a short summary of the total text. Eg: A Dog, The Panda

Classification - Tells what the animal "is". What class it belongs to, eg mammal, amphibian, reptile.

Description - Tells what attributes the animal has. What it looks like (size, shape, colour, features).

Location - Tells where it is found (Country). Where it lives (habitat).

Dynamics - Explains what the animal does. How it moves, what it does, what it eats etc.

Summarizing comment - A statement that finishes the writing (not a personal comment), a general fact not covered in other areas.

HINTS FOR WRITING A REPORT

- Each part is written in a new paragraph with a line missed between paragraphs.
- Each paragraph begins with the name of the thing the report is about.
- A report uses "it" or 'they', not he or she.
