

MLA BIBLIOGRAPHY FORMAT

Book

Author's Name (last name, first). *Title of Book*. City of Publication: Name of Publisher, Copyright Date.

Example:

King, Joe. *A Short History of the Entire World*. NY: Dell Publishing, 1998.

Another example with two authors:

Jones, Amy and Smith, Tom. *My Life as a Teenager*. Washington, DC: Benchmark Books, 1992.

Internet Site

(Most Internet sites do not have authors listed—just start your citation with the site name.)

Author's Name (last name, first). "The Site Name." <The site address>. The date you went on to the Internet and found the site.

Example:

Ha, Tony. "Mars, Our Closest Neighbor." <<http://www.mars-is-a-page.com>>. February 12, 1998.

Encyclopedia Article from Online Database

Author's Name (last name, first). "Title of the Article." *Name of the Encyclopedia*. Date published. *Name of the Database used*. <URL of database's homepage>. Date you looked at article.

Example:

Weingast, David E. "Electoral college." *New Book of Knowledge Encyclopedia*, 2004. *Grolier Online*. <<http://go.grolier.com>>. March 22, 2004.
