

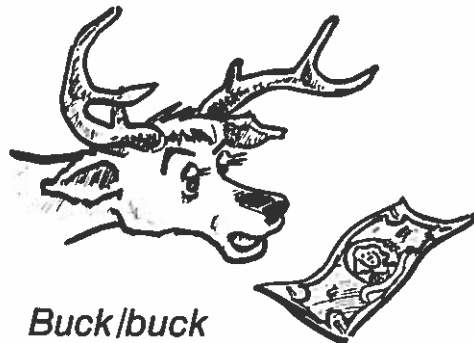
List 26: Homographs

OBJECTIVE

To develop the student's ability to understand the different meanings of homograph pairs and to use the words appropriately in functional language.

APPLICATIONS
