**SUBJECT : Transfer of IPC Licence Reg No. 53**

The Agency received an application for the transfer of IPC licence Register Number 53 on 12/01/06 from ADM Ringaskiddy to Corrin MDA Ltd., Fermoy, County Cork. Further information in the form of a map showing the extent of the ADM property was received on the 17<sup>th</sup> January '06. Having assessed the application I wrote to Mr Pat O'Flynn of Corrin MDA Ltd to request additional information which I deemed was missing from the application, to show compliance with Sections 94(5) and (6) of the EPA Act (1992) as amended by the Protection of the Environment Act (2003). This included information to show that the proposed transferee is a fit and proper person to as per Section 84(4) of the Act. This letter was copied to Mr Michael Donovan, ADM Ringaskiddy. On foot of this request additional information was received by the Agency in Headquarters on 20/02/06.

I have assessed this application and I deem it to comply with the requirements of Section 94 of the Act:

- The application was jointly made i.e. by both the current licensee and the proposed transferee ( S.94(2));
- A letter was received from Pat O'Flynn, of Corrin MDA Ltd. confirming that the Directors and employees of Corrin MDA Ltd have not been convicted of an offence under the Waste Management Act, 1996, the EPA Act, 1992 – 2003, the Local Government (Water Pollution) Acts 1977 and 1990 or the Air Pollution Act, 1987 (S.84 (4)(a)).
