

5. chiasmus

- a sentence in which two words in the first half are criss-crossed in the second half
 - Examples:
 - “All for one, and one for all!”
 - » from *The Three Musketeers*
 - “Ask not what your country can do for you, but what you can do for your country.”
 - » JFK’s *Inaugural Address*, Jan. 20, 1961
