Now a division of Justice Resource Institute, Inc., CFYS is a not-for-profit agency which offers two residential schools for girls aged 13-17 (Walden Street School in Concord and Pelham Academy in Lexington); a therapeutic high school (The Victor School); a diagnostic assessment program for adolescents in crisis (DAP); a transitional/independent living shelter for young adults in Lowell; a group home for boys aged 13-17 (The Littleton Group Home); comprehensive parenting services for all residents (First Connections) and for first time mothers under 21 (Healthy Families at Emerson Hospital); adoption referral and information services; and a social worker for at-risk students in Acton Boxborough High School.
