DR(MRS) ELIZABETH OLANIKE ODUWOLE

Dr (Mrs.) Elizabeth Olanike Oduwole (nee Ayo) was born on the 1st of June, 1957. She attended Ereko Methodist School, Lagos for Primary Education and went to Queen's School, Ibadan from 1969-1973 for her Secondary Education. She thereafter went to the Polytechnic, Ibadan from 1975-1977 for her Advanced Level.

She gained admission into the prestigious University of Ibadan to study Medicine in 1977 and qualified as a Medical Doctor with the degree of MB, BS in June, 1983. Her National Youth Service was at the Nigerian Airforce, Kaduna in 1984 to 1985. She later attended University of Lagos in 1989 where she studied and obtained a Post graduate Diploma in Anaesthesia.

She started her working career at two private hospitals in Kaduna namely NEVADA Specialist Hospital and JINYA Hospital in Kaduna in 1985. She later got a job at the Kaduna State Health Management Board, Kaduna where she was posted to the New General Hospital, GRA, Kaduna. She served for Nine (9) months and had to relocate to Lagos in November, 1986. She joined the Lagos State Government on the 1st of December, 1986 as a Medical Officer. She served in various hospital units namely Mainland Hospital 1986-1989, General Hospital, Lagos 1989-1996(Registrar/Senior Registrar), Lagos Island Maternity Hospital 1996 -1999(Consultant) , Lagos State Accident and Emergency Services(LASEMS) 1999 -2001(Consultant Anaesthetist and Head),

General Hospital, Apapa 2001-2007 (Consultant Anaesthetist and Head of Department), General Hospital, Apapa 2007 -2015 (Medical Director) and Permanent Secretary 2015 till date.

As a Permanent Secretary, She was the pioneer Permanent Secretary at then newly created Ministry of Wealth Creation and Employment. She was posted to the Ministry of Women Affairs and Poverty Alleviation from where she moved to the Audit Service Commission where she is at present.

In the course of her career, she attended several Local and International Courses.
