



Construction Scope of Work (subject to change)

Remodeled Façade, Church Entrance and Narthex. A beautifully designed front entry way will provide for a liturgically highlighted means of invitation for entry into the sacred space of the church. The new design is a show-stopper, and will serve as an important landmark for UCSB students. It will be immediately recognizable as a Roman Catholic Church with an appropriate local Santa Barbara Mission-style architectural theme.

Multi-Purpose Hall. This multi-purpose dining hall will have table and chair storage and be able to seat approximately 60 persons for meals and up to 80 for lectures and other row-seated events.

Commercial Style Kitchen. A highly functional facility, immediately off the Dining Hall, will allow for larger-scale meals and meeting events. The kitchen will be located next to the proposed new hall, allowing for much better serving flow into the hall or into the church for large events.

Outdoor Patio entry. A wonderful addition and a new way for students and parishioners to enjoy mild Santa Barbara weather in a semi-enclosed protected area.

Upgraded Men's and Women's Restroom Facilities. These will be brought up to current building codes by creating larger facilities.

Re-model of Office Space. Addition of two additional needed office spaces for staff.

New church glass windows. Seven 3x16' new windows that will echo the beauty of the new external mission-style theme.

Improved HVAC, Internet and Electrical systems for office and rectory. The HVAC and electrical system is nearing fifty years of age. A new HVAV system will move heating more efficiently through the buildings.
