When you have completed your Basic Training you will be sent information about Advanced Training requirements.

The Leader now:

- Elects whether they wish to pursue VET Certificate III qualifications as well as Gilwell Training
- Commences working on eLearning Modules.
- Books into an Advanced Training Course (and 7hr CSE course for Leader of Adult {LOA})
- Completes the pre-course assignment – **must** be done **before** attending the face-to-face training.

GILWELL ONLY STREAM

- Download attachments from eLearning modules and complete.
- Many of the attachments can be completed at the face to face training.
- Forward the completed folder to Scout HQ for assessment.

GILWELL + VET STREAM

- Download Certificate IV attachments from eLearning modules and complete.
- Forward the completed folder to Scout HQ for assessment as 'competent'.
- Decides to seek VET qualification.
- Completes a SAIT enrolment form and gains a USI.
- Submits Portfolio of Evidence for Assessment

eLEARNING MODULES

- At home, in your own time and at your own pace. It should take you about 16 hours.
- E Learning must be started, and should be completed, before attending the first face to face course.

FACE TO FACE TRAINING

This course can be booked as soon as E Learning has been started.

- All Leaders (LOY and LOA): – Attend an Advanced Training Course: One non- residential weekend.
- Rovers: - Attend an Advanced Training Course: One non- residential weekend.
- Child Safe Environments Course: 3 hour for LOY (included in Basic Course) - 7 hour for LOA and Rovers as a separate course.
