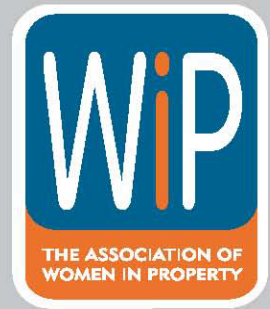


Boardroom Insights: Financial Literacy for the Boardroom
