



## Scholarship Contract 2011-2012

The USC Rossier School of Education awards you the MAT@USC Scholarship based on meeting the following conditions:

- You must enroll in the program and begin classes in September 2011. Your scholarship funds will be applied to the Fall Semester 2011.
- You must be registered as a full-time student to be eligible for the award.
- Scholarship awards are made in the form of a tuition credit and are posted directly to your USC student fee bill at the beginning of the term specified in the contract. You are responsible for settling your fee bill according to the University schedule for fee payment.
- The scholarship program is a privilege, not a right. Scholarships may be discontinued for failure to make academic progress or for violating the University's student conduct policy.
- Your scholarship is calculated into your financial aid budget, and may affect the amount of student loan funding for which you are eligible. - International students must complete the "Certificate of Foreign Status of Beneficial Owner for United States Tax Withholding" Form before funds can be disbursed. You will receive the form upon the return of your scholarship contract.
