

## Scholarship Budget Form For Upcoming Academic Year

### Instructions:

• Fillable .pdf's **ONLY** work when saved and completed from your desktop and not an internet browser. Save this form to your desktop using the file name format below prior to filling in the relevant information and then **reopen, complete, save and upload**:

*FirstNameLastNameBudget.pdf (Eg. JohnSmithBudget.pdf).*

- Keep in mind that this budget is for your upcoming academic year (an 8-month period), not your entire program.
- Enter amounts into the grey boxes for the line items that are relevant to you.

**Note:** Total resources, total expenses and total shortfall fields **automatically calculate** based on the amounts that you enter into the grey boxes. **NUMBERS ONLY IN THE GREY BOXES, NO TEXT.**

• Most line items ask for annualized amounts. However, housing, living and travel expenses call for **monthly** amounts, as monthly billing is typical for these types of expenses. In these sections, the form will automatically translate your monthly expenses into a total amount for an 8-month academic year.
