Also address any of the following topics which may apply to you:

- ◆ The college or university you plan/hope to attend and your reason for that choice.
- ◆ Your expected course of study and career goals.
- ◆ Any challenges (other than financial) that you are facing (physical, family, etc) and how you are coping with them.
- ◆ The variety of your hobbies, skills, talents, etc. and their importance in your life.
- ◆ Your work experience, projects or other responsibilities you've been involved in, including paid and volunteer work.
- ◆ Relevant awards or recognition that you have received.
- ◆ Other information about yourself that makes you uniquely qualified to receive this scholarship.

Step 6 **Provide an Official Transcript**
