## DEATH NOTICES

A death notice is a paid posting that announces an individual's passing. It may also include information regarding funeral arrangements and memorial services and details about their life such as education, employment, religious and civic affiliations and information about the family such as relatives, both living and deceased.

The News & Observer and our community of newspapers offer print and online death notice packages to provide this service in a respectful and effective manner. Death notices published in the N&O are posted online for one full year at [www.legacy.com/newsobserver/Obituaries](http://www.legacy.com/newsobserver/Obituaries). The online listing includes the Legacy Guest Book service. Death notices that are published in the community papers only will appear online for 1 year at each community paper website.

## IN MEMORIAM

An In Memoriam is an announcement placed by family members or friends in remembrance of a loved one. An In Memoriam may be used to mark an anniversary of one's passing, a special holiday like veterans or father's day or birthday. Scripture, poems and photos are welcomed. In Memoriams appear on The News & Observer's death notice pages or can be ordered for community papers as individual ads.

### *The News & Observer*

\$41.20 per inch with approximately 8 lines to the inch. \$5.15 per line.

### *The Community Newspapers*

\$12.80 per inch with approximately 8 lines to the inch. \$1.60 per line.

Photos are included at the line rate and measure at 8 lines to the inch.

## PAYMENT

In-state funeral home may be billed. Out-of-state funeral homes must pre-pay unless an account has been pre-approved by our credit department. Obituaries and memoriam placed by individuals must be prepaid with credit or bankcard.

## DEADLINES

The obituary department is available from 9am until 4:30 pm weekdays and 1:00pm – 4:30pm on Saturday and Sunday. The deadline for death notices in The News & Observer is daily at 4:30pm for the next day. Deadline for Community papers varies and is listed by publication on the preceding page.

## LEGACY GUEST BOOK

The Legacy Guest Book is a Web-based tool for friends and families to share thoughts and memories. It is included with the online posting of the death notice. All entries are reviewed for appropriate content before appearing online. There is no limit to the number of entries. Guest book remains online for one full year. Entries may be added from anywhere at any time via the Internet. Photos with captions may be uploaded with an entry and/or into the Photo Gallery. Full-size notices are posted online for one full year. Smaller notices (such as changes and cancellations) are posted for 30 days. If the online guest book is sponsored, the notice may stay online longer.

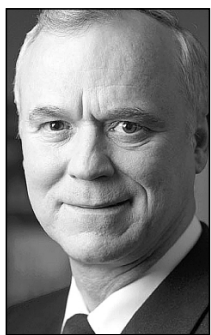

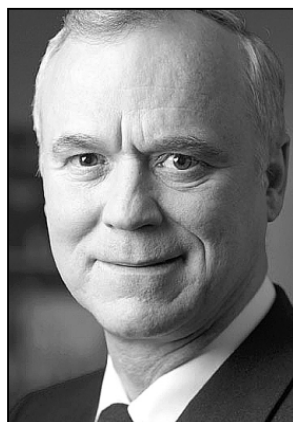

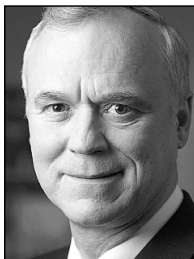
