

Vehicle Service Contract Program Agreement Dated _____
Between Nationwide CAC LLC and Its Successors (Hereinafter "Nationwide") and
_____ and Its Successors (Hereinafter "Dealer")

- 1) Dealer wishes to participate in Nationwide's Vehicle Service Contract Program ("Program"), which allows dealers an opportunity to offer for sale to customers a vehicle service contract ("VSC") from Route 66 Extended Warranty to be placed by Nationwide. This product is available for contracts sold to Nationwide only and is not to be used with other finance companies. The Program is voluntary on the part of the dealer and will not affect any aspect of Nationwide's evaluation or willingness to purchase retail installment contracts ("RIC") from Dealer. If Nationwide's approval of a customer's application allows, Dealer may offer a VSC in a RIC for that customer. Dealer is not required to participate in the Program and may offer VSC from other approved vendors in addition to or instead of Route 66 and finance them in the RIC to be purchased by Nationwide. VSC products must be selected by customers on a completely voluntary basis and must not be a condition of financing.
- 2) For each sale by Dealer of a VSC under the Program placed by Nationwide, Dealer shall receive compensation ("Compensation") from Nationwide, such compensation amount to be set by Nationwide.
- 3) In the event that a VSC is cancelled, Dealer shall refund to Nationwide the Compensation pro-rata upon demand by Nationwide.
- 4) Dealer shall accurately and fully describe the cost, benefits and limitations of the VSC to each customer.
- 5) Dealer must include a signed Nationwide Vehicle Service Contract Disclosure form with the RIC funding package, in addition to the signed Route 66 Service Agreement.
- 6) Dealer must include a copy of the Route 66 VSC Disclosure form and a printout of the VSC Service Quote from the Route 66 website (www.route66warranty.com) with the RIC funding package.
- 7) Dealer shall not change the cost to the customer from the amount quoted from the Route 66 website.
- 8) Dealer shall disclose the cost of the VSC and Route 66 Warranty in the Itemization of the Amount Financed on each RIC under Amounts Paid to Others on Your Behalf.
- 9) Nationwide reserves the right to modify, amend or terminate the Program at any time upon notice to Dealer.
- 10) Dealer shall comply with all applicable consumer protection laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, the Equal Credit Opportunity Act and Truth-in-Lending Act.

- 11) Dealer shall not engage in any unfair, deceptive, or abusive acts and practices. Dealer shall handle and respond to all consumer complaints received by Dealer and shall notify Nationwide in writing within 3 business days of any complaints pertaining to the sale, application and financing of goods or services sold by Dealer through Nationwide's Program.
- 12) Dealer has been informed and understands that the sale and marketing of ancillary products has been subject to scrutiny by various governmental agencies and that consumer finance companies have been charged with the responsibility of overseeing the marketing and sale of such products. Accordingly, Dealer agrees that Nationwide shall have the right from time to time on reasonable notice to Dealer to review Dealer's books and records to verify Dealer's compliance with numbers 10 and 11 above.
- 13) This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and all such counterparts shall constitute one Agreement. Facsimile or email signatures shall be accepted in effectuating this Agreement. Any Party to this Agreement may rely upon a copy of an executed signature page transmitted by facsimile or portable document format (PDF) as if it were an original.
