

Working Theme Statements for *Of Mice and Men*

Topic/Subject/Concept	Working Theme Statement
Friendship / Companionship	Brian: Sometimes friendship requires the ultimate sacrifice of killing your friend to prevent a worse outcome for him/her.
	Brian: Friendship means being together, but at some point having personal space is needed.
Ambition / Dreams / Goals	Brian: Dreams keep you going and morale high.
	Ashley/Kyra: One person's dream might be another's nightmare
	If your dreams don't come true, you might give up, and that can lead to loneliness and depression
Loneliness / Alienation	Ashley: Loneliness can cause depression and can make you take drastic actions (Curley's wife talked to Lennie even though he was potentially dangerous)
	Ariel: Loneliness can only go so long before we need human contact/comfort (Crooks).
Discrimination / Prejudice	Ariel/Bibi: Discrimination leads to loneliness or hating humankind
	Discrimination can limit your abilities to be happy or to go certain places.
Guilt	Kyra: Guilt can be turned into personal pleasure--
	Kewon: Guilt is used as a weapon to make people take responsibility for how they treat others.
