Members of the public joining the call are asked to mute their phones upon joining. Anyone joining who fails to do so may be muted by the call moderator or removed from the call

The maximum capacity for the teleconference is 350 people

The Board may convene in a closed session, in accordance with the Maryland Annotated Code, General Provisions Article, §3-101. Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Open Meetings Act authorizing the closed meeting

The Board will go into closed session immediately after opening the meeting at 3:00 PM to discuss administrative, quasi-judicial, and personnel matters in accordance with the Open Meetings Act and then re-open the meeting at 5:00 PM
