

ADVERB AVENUE

To practice what we know about adverbs, you will create an "Adverb Avenue". You will fill your 'avenue' with houses, cars, clouds, the sun, people, stores and other things you might find on an avenue. Attached to your poster, you will write four (4) sentences about the picture (you may write these on the back of the picture). Paper must be no smaller than 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 11".

You will need one sentence for each:

- Using an adverb to tell 'where'
- Using an adverb to tell 'when'
- Using an adverb to tell 'how often'
- Using an adverb to tell 'how' or in 'what manner'

You **must** underline the ADVERB and draw an arrow to the VERB it is modifying in each sentence. You **must** also write the KIND of adverb used (where, when, how often, how)

Pictures may be drawn or pieces cut and pasted from a magazine and/or internet pictures (must be school appropriate).
