

SOME TYPES OF FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE

<u>TERM</u>	<u>EXAMPLE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
Metaphor	Time is a thief	Don't use like or as to Compare. Try is instead!
Simile	Time is LIKE a thief	Use Like or AS to compare
Personification	You're as dumb as a rock!	Human Characteristics to inanimate object
Hyperbole	I could eat a Wookie!	Extreme exaggerations
Symbolism	Using an APPLE to represent education	A word that has deep meaning
Alliteration	Wild Willy Weeps while Watching Whales	Repeating a consonant sound
Onomatopoeia	Buzz, Zap, Meow, Crunch, Pow, Boom...	Words that sound like their meaning
Assonance	I ride on the tide as I Lie on my kite	Repetition of the VOWEL sound
