1. 2. Relevance of Images	<b>Student cannot give an explanation why he/she chose the images included.</b>	<b>Student can give only a basic explanation why he/she chose the images included.</b>	<b>Student can give a reasonable explanation why he/she chose the images included.</b>	<b>Student can give a detailed, clear and reasonable explanation why he/she chose the images included.</b>
