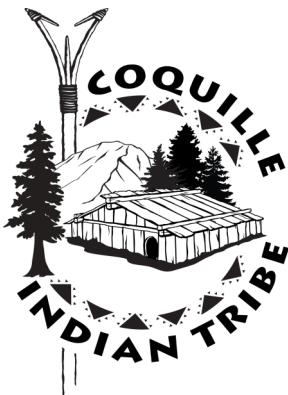

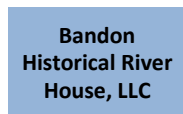

South Coast Hospice Services

End of Life Care

- South Coast Hospice provides compassionate and quality end of life care for those who qualify. (Referred by a physician, live in area and have a prognosis of 6 months or less.)
- Service area includes Coos, Northern Curry, and Coastal Douglas counties.
- Patients can keep their primary care physician if they choose. SCH provides every patient a physician-led care team comprised of a primary care nurse, an LPN, a social worker, home health aides and a chaplain and trained volunteer, if desired.
- SCH will pay for the medications related to the patient's terminal illness and those that provide comfort and pain management.
- Durable equipment such as hospital beds, commodes, shower chairs, walkers, wheelchairs, etc. is provided as needed to help the patient remain independent and mobile as long as possible and aide the caregivers to safely care for their loved one.
- Patients and their caregivers can access a South Coast Hospice triage nurse 24/7, 365 days a year.
- Social workers inform them of end of life resources and help them navigate various government and social service systems. Many of our patients are in need of additional services to address issues of hunger, homelessness, mental health, caregiving, poverty, and geographical and social isolation.
- Chaplains are non-denominational and offer spiritual support when requested. They will also connect patients with spiritual leaders of their particular belief system.

Grief Support

- Hospices are required by Medicare to provide grief support to the loved ones of patients for up to 13 months after the patient has died. SCH welcomes anyone from the community who is grieving the loss of a loved one.
- South Coast Hospice offers free grief support groups in Bandon, Coos Bay, Coquille and Reedsport. These meet twice a month and are facilitated by an experienced social worker. Those interested can call our Family Services Department at 541-269-2986.
- In response to community need, SCH offers additional grief support groups for those whose loved one may have died unexpectedly. Survivors of Suicide (S.O.S.) supports those who lost a loved one to suicide. The Sudden or Unexpected Loss (S.O.U.L.) group helps those whose family member or friend may have died in an accident, from a heart attack or other occurrence.

Community

- Community Education & Volunteer Training Classes: The free 11 week class covers topics about the death & dying process to best prepare hospice volunteers, but can benefit anyone caring for a loved one.
- Community Presentations: SCH offers free presentations by trained and experienced professionals on topics such as understanding advance directives, positive communications with those who are ill or bereaved, preventing caregiver burn out, and more.
- SCH Thrift Store: Affordable clothing and household goods for community members. Provides goods for hospice patients and family members. Generates revenue for patient care services.
- Cancer Support Group: SCH has hosted this group that meets weekly for over 30 years.
- Community Bereavement & Education Center: Available to rent for a small fee for meetings & parties.
