### Book with one author

Author's last name, First name. *Title*. Publication place: Publisher, Date of publication. The word "Print".

Mumford, Lewis. *The Culture of Cities*. New York: Harcourt, 1938. Print.

### Two or more books by the same author

Author's last name, First name. *Title*. Publication place: Publisher, Date of publication. The word "Print".

Carr, Emily. *The Book of Small*. Toronto: Clarke, 1942. Print.

-----, *The House of All Sorts*. Toronto: Oxford Press, 1944. Print.

### Book with two or three authors

First author's last name, First name, Second author's First name Last name, and Third author's First name Last name. *Title*. Publication place: Publisher, Date of publication. The word "Print".

Conrad, Margaret, Alvin Finkel, and Cornelius Jaenen. *History of the Canadian Peoples*.

Mississauga: Copp Clarke Pitman, 1993. Print.

### Book with an editor

Editor's last name, First name, ed. *Title*. Publication place: Publisher, Date of publication. The word "Print".

Lopate, Phillip, ed. *The Art of the Personal Essay: An Anthology from the Classical Era to the Present*. New York: Anchor-Doubleday, 1994. Print.

### Encyclopedia article

Article author's last name, First name. "Article title." *Encyclopedia title*. Publication place: Publisher, Date of publication. The word "Print".

Roche, Douglas. "Peace Movement." *Canadian Encyclopedia*. Edmonton: Hurtig, 1988. Print.

### Periodical (Magazine or Newspaper) Article

Article author's last name, First name. "Article title." *Magazine/newspaper title*. Date of publication: pages. The word "Print".

Rybczynski, Witold. "Designs for Escape." *The New Yorker*. 16 Oct. 1995: 160-63. Print.

### Periodical (Magazine or Newspaper Article) from an Online Database

Article author's last name, First name. "Article title." *Magazine/newspaper title*. Date of publication: pages. *Database name*. The word "Web". Date visited.

"Japanese Internment Camp Project." *Instructor*. August 2004: 8(1). *General Reference Center Gold*. Web. 09 January 2006.

### Work Cited only on Web (with author)

Author's last name, First name. Article title (if available). *Web site name*. Publisher of Web Site (if not available, use N. p.). The word "Web". Date visited.

New, M. Christopher. *Maryland Loyatism - Historical Overview*. N.p. Web. 21 Sept. 2004.

### A Print Work Also Cited On Web

Author's last name, First name. *Title*. Publication place: Publisher, Date of publication. *Web site name*. The word "Web". Date visited.

**Example:** Whitman, Walt. *Leaves of Grass*. Brooklyn, 1855. *The Walt Whitman Archive*. Web. 12 Mar. 2007.
