# Volunteer Opportunities

| Volunteer Assignment   | Duties   |
|------------------------|--|
| Hospitality/Greeters   | Greet players during registration, staff concierge tables, provide access to areas of the Clubhouse, and act as greeters at parent concierge/volunteer check-in.                                 |
| Scoring Control        | Monitor radio communications and notify the rules committee and staff of requests for rules official or medical personnel. Receive hole-by-hole information on the leaders from Walking Scorers. |
| Walking Scorers        | Walk with assigned group, update individual scores with standard bearer boards and scoring control at the conclusion of each hole.   |
| Leaderboards           | Update on-course leaderboards and main scoreboard with scoring control.  |
| Course Shuttles        | Shuttle players between holes and to the driving range, and shuttle volunteers to volunteer sites.   |
| Spotters               | Assist players with ball location on a few specific holes.   |
| Observers              | Assist referees with ball location throughout the entire round of assigned group.  |
| Volunteer Registration | Greet guests, sign-in volunteers, sign-in college coaches, and provide relief to marshals mid-shift.   |
