


Tissue Box Book Report Template

Here is how the project is completed:

1. Measure and draw lines on the bottom of the tissue box. After, cut along the lines to make the tissue box open. Be sure to only cut the lines and do not cut the flaps off. The result should be like the partially completed project in the photo on the right.
2. Decorate the outside of the tissue like a farm, prairie, wagon, or anything else you can think of from Sarah, Plain and Tall!
3. Write one or two complete sentences summarizing the first couple of chapters on the "Beginning" template. After writing, cut out the "Beginning" template and glue it on the inside of the left flap on the tissue box.
4. Repeat the writing as the book progresses with the "Middle" panel. The large square on the same page is a frame for a picture. Draw a picture of any scene from Sarah, Plain and Tall. The picture fits inside the box on the top, and the "Middle" panel on the bottom. The writing and drawing should be completed before cutting and gluing.
5. Repeat the writing for the last couple of chapters on the "Ending" panel. The "Ending" panel goes on the inside right flap of the tissue box. The title panel can go on either the top or bottom flap of the tissue box.
6. The "Problem" and "Solution" panels can go on the outside of left and right sides of the tissue box, the "Character" and "Setting" panel can go on the rear of the tissue box.
