




Squadron Line Book Dedication Program

Dedicating a book is a great way to acknowledge a special event such as a birthday or holiday, to honor a special teacher or to recognize a special person in your student's life.

Here's how it works

- The form below and \$15.00 payment is returned to school
- The student comes to the media center where a volunteer will help him/her to select a special book
- Mr. Sepa has a selection of brand new hardcover books reserved for this program
- A book plate will be affixed inside the book acknowledging the dedication
- The student's picture is taken holding the book and the picture will be displayed in the hallway outside the library*
- The details of the dedication will be recorded in the Squadron Line Library Media Center Book Dedication Album
- The student is the first one to check the book out of the library
- When the book is returned, it becomes part of the Squadron Line Library Media Center collection

If you are honoring a SQ staff member, he/she will be notified of the dedication.
