**You are invited to submit** an abstract in one of these categories: 1) EBP, 2) clinical research, 3) synthesis report, 4) quality improvement, or 5) nurse residency project from a supporting organization. Of particular interest are abstracts related to the conference purpose and theme as well as innovative EBP projects or topics.

### Accepted Abstracts

- Abstracts will be accepted for poster display or 20-minute oral presentation.
- Research, EBP, and synthesis projects completed by 12/31/22 will be considered for oral presentation and those that are in-progress will be considered for poster. Quality improvement and nurse residency abstracts will be considered for poster presentation.
- Following peer review, acceptance notices with presentation details will be sent in late November. Please note that reviewers may determine that abstract is of a different category than selected.
- Two presenters per accepted abstract are eligible for a registration discount. Both presenters must submit registration payment by mid-December. All other costs and arrangements shall be assumed by the presenters.

### Guidelines for Abstract Submission

- Prepare blinded abstract using the templates provided at [uihc.org/national-evidence-based-practice-conference](https://uihc.org/national-evidence-based-practice-conference).
- Abstract and references each limited to 500 words, title and headings are not counted.
- Nurse residency coordinators may submit up to two abstracts, selected by their organization, for poster consideration.
