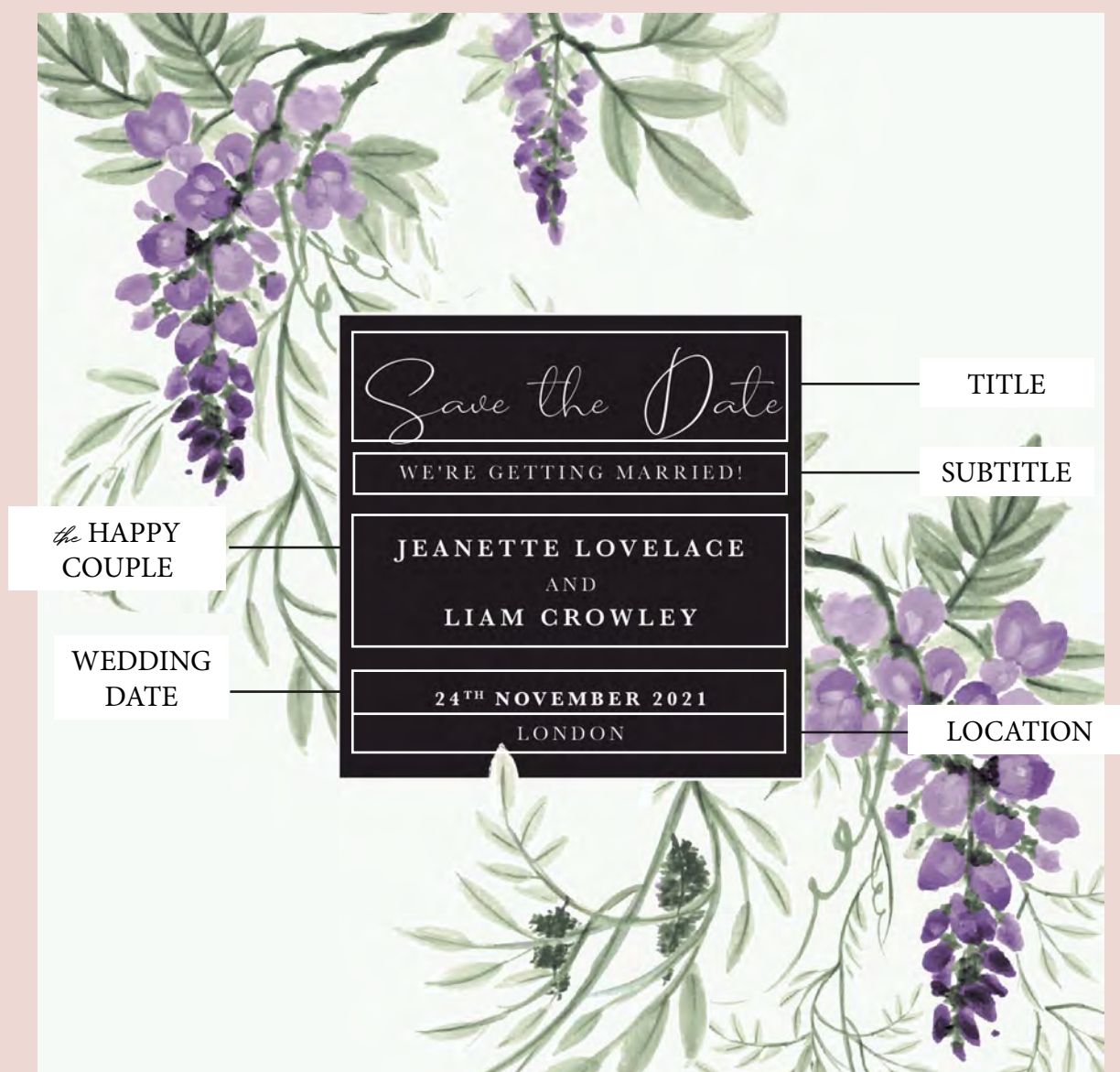

Save the Date

EXAMPLE LAYOUT



EXTRA DETAILS
e.g. invitation to flow, rsvp, etc.

TITLE FOR CARD

For example, "Save the Date" or "We're Getting Married!".

SUBHEADING

Optional. Add a sub-heading above the names on your card. For example, if you have used "We're Getting Married!" as the main title, you may want to set this to "Save the Date".

We're getting married!

Other (enter below)

THE HAPPY COUPLE

In general, the bride's name comes first. If you are opting for an informal feel to your invitations then you can use your first names only, for more formal invitations it is usual to use your full names.

NAME 1

&

NAME 2

WEDDING DATE

E.g. "12th September 2022" or "12/09/2024".

LOCATION

Usually you would type the name of the venue and a reference to the town or county only as this looks more elegant. For example, "All Souls Church, Islington" or "Strathmore House, Manchester". You might not have your venue finalised yet—in this case, use the town or county only. For destination weddings don't forget to add the country!

EXTRA DETAILS

Is there anything else you would like printing on your cards?

For example, "Formal invitation to follow" or "Please RSVP to Jenna Baker by..."
