A bio-poem is a structured collection of vivid details about a person's life, personality traits and aspirations; essentially, it is the same as a portrait but in words. In creating your bio-poem, try to avoid generalizations, which tend to be boring and uninteresting, in favor of vivid, specific details which reveal interesting aspects of your subject.

- Line 2: (4 traits that describe the subject's personality)
- Line 3: "Relative or Friend of..."(list three relatives or friends)
- Line 4: (Position, job, way that to identify the subject)
- Line 5: "Lover of..." (three things, people, activities...)
- Line 6: "Who feels..." (three emotions and explanations)
- Line 7: "Who has been..." (three places or events)
- Line 8: "Who needs..."(three descriptions)
- Line 9: "Who fears..." (three descriptions)
- Line 10: "Who gives..." (three descriptions)
- Line 11: "Who longs for..." (three descriptions)
- Line 12: "Who would like to see..." (three descriptions)
- Line 13: (Synonym – one or two words that describes the subject)
- Line 14: "Resident of..." (description of place, dates, location...)
- Line 15: (Last name)
