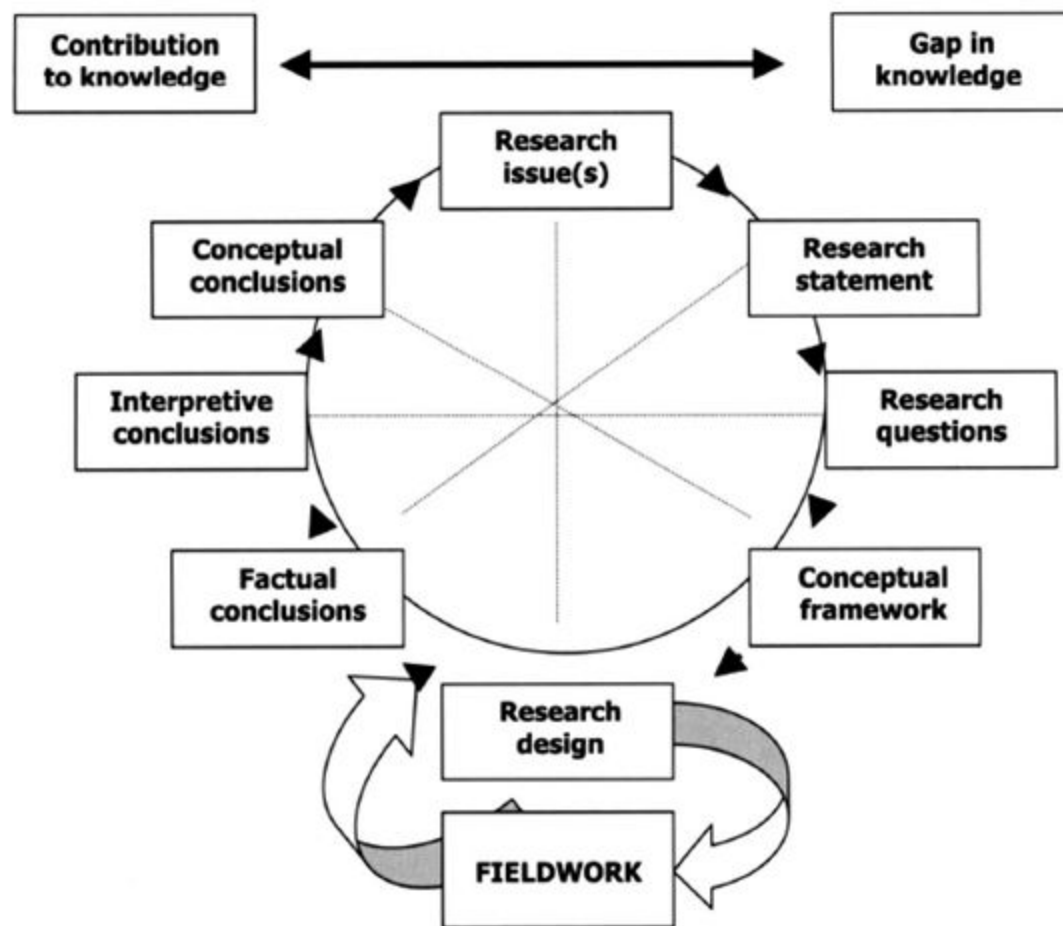
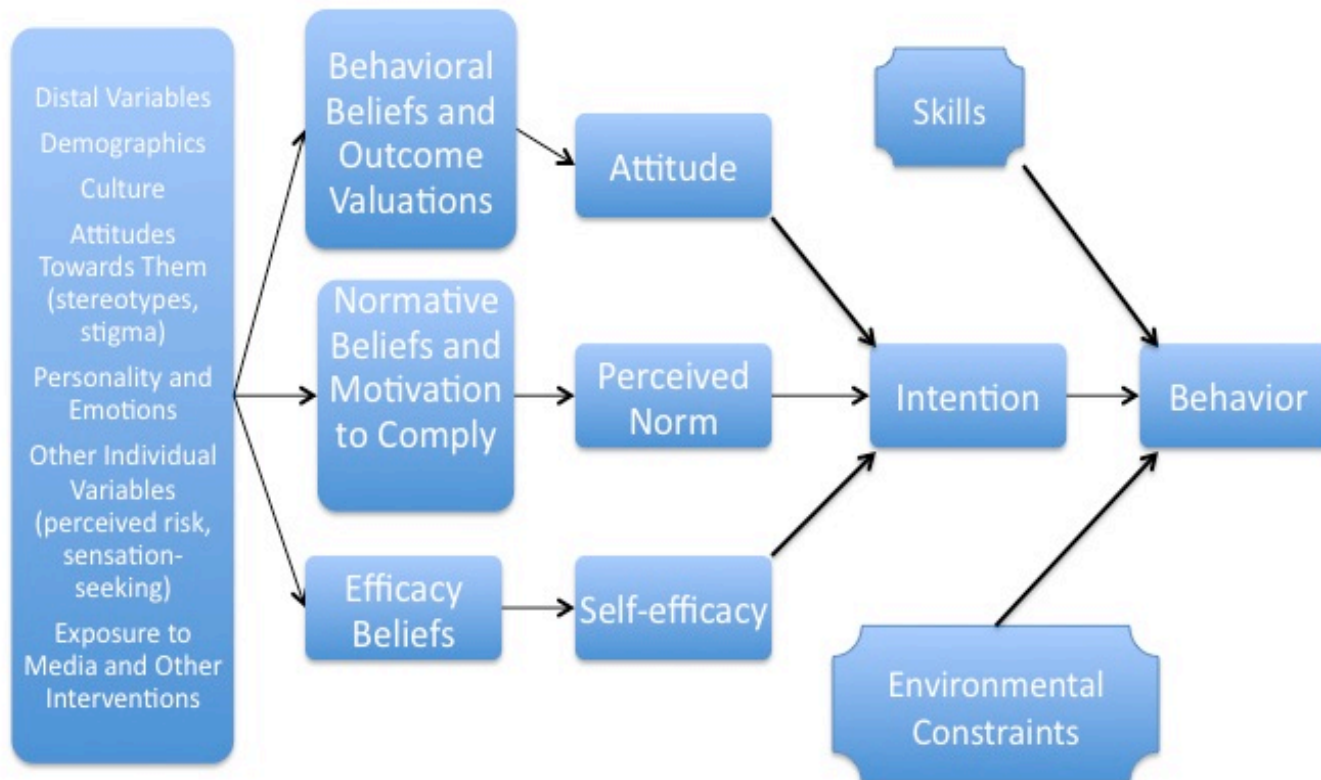


Figure 2. Visualising the doctoral research process

Why bother with a theoretical framework?

- Explains and predicts relationships, events, behaviour
- Provides a context for examining a problem
- Provides an overview of interrelated concepts
- Provides a rationale for developing hypotheses
- Serves as a guide to systematically identify relationships between variables

An Integrative Model of Behavior Prediction

Framework = Big picture

- ✓ Rationale for predictions about relationships among the variables in your data
- ✓ Simplicity, best as one visual
- ✓ Get feedback from peers, supervisor

Where do I find my framework?

Where do I find my framework?

1. In other publications that are part of your background
2. Create your own (harder than it looks)
3. Put in the keywords into a search engine:

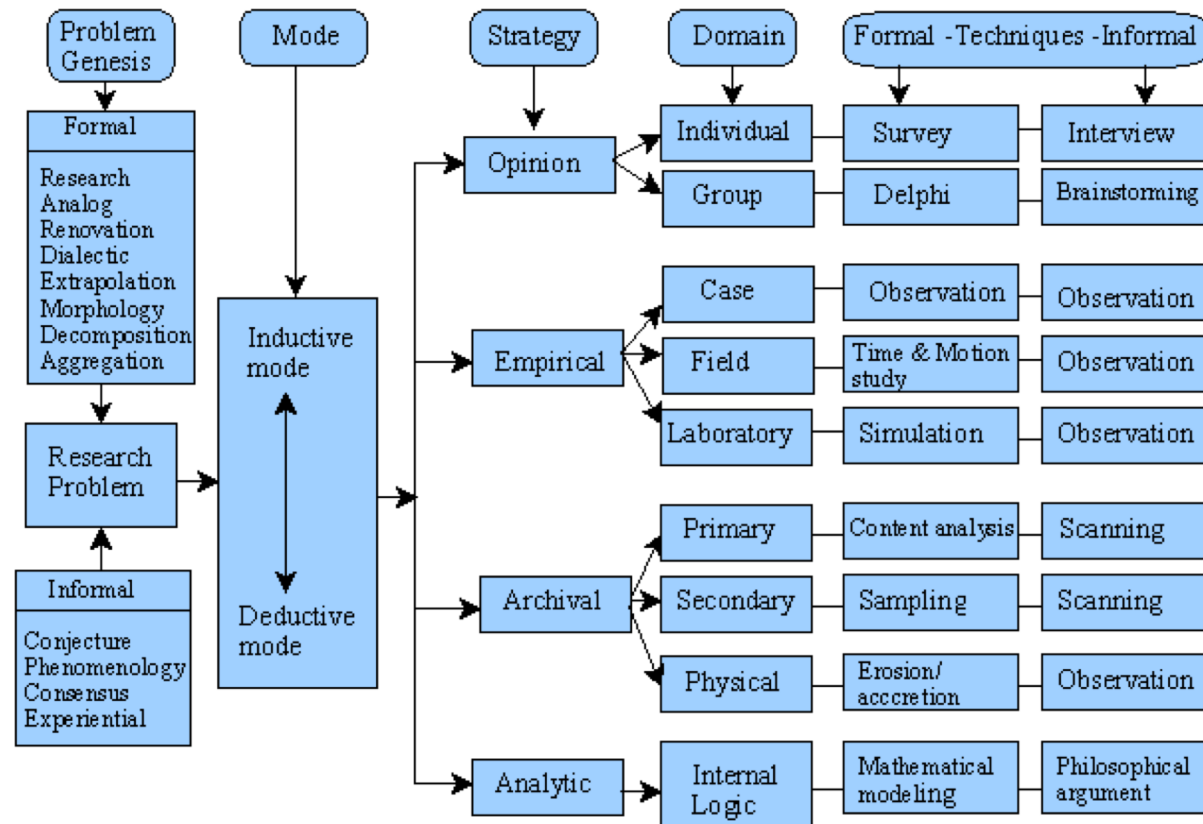


If you use an existing model/framework...

- Use the original **title** and **reference** the original source
- Do not change or DELETE the parts you are not studying
- Your thesis will not cover the entire model, but a part
- Do not mix and match models or frameworks, stick to one that fits best

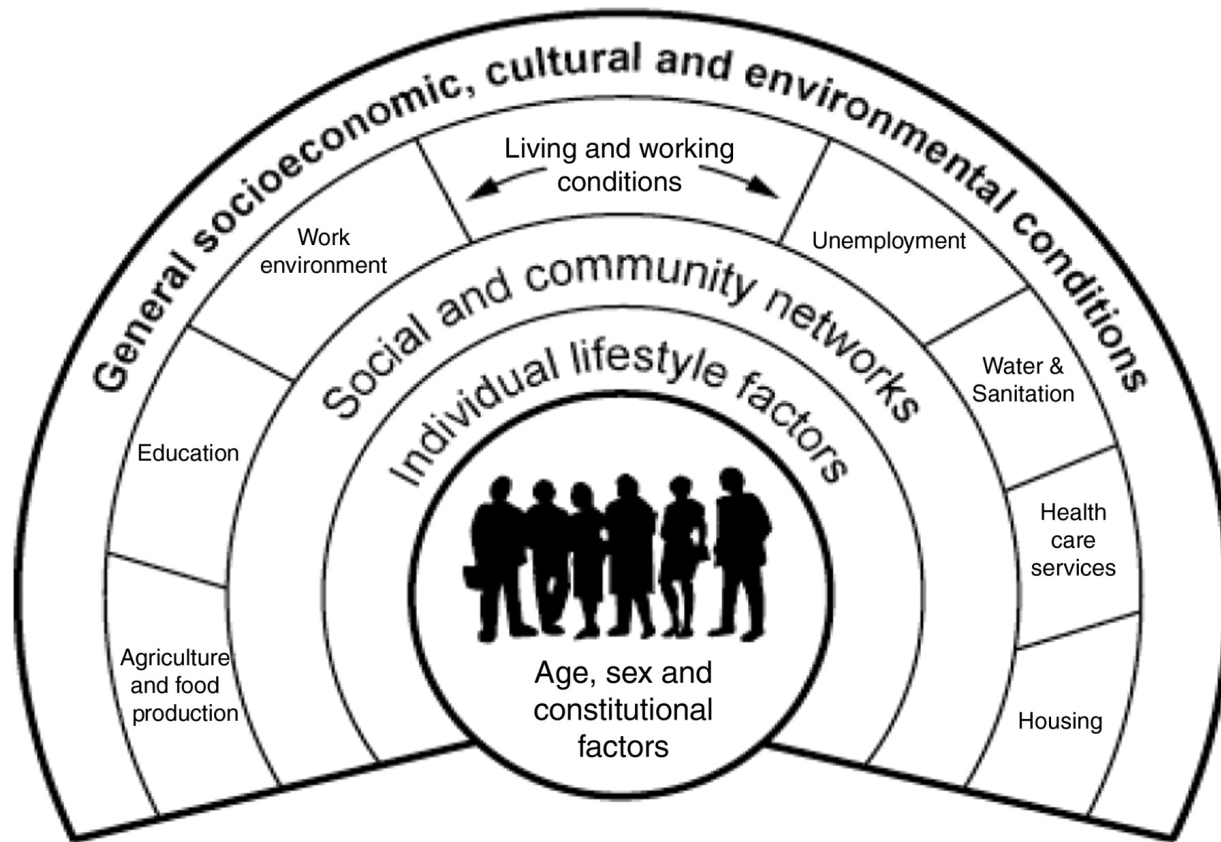
Example of a poor model/framework

A Framework for Research Methodology*



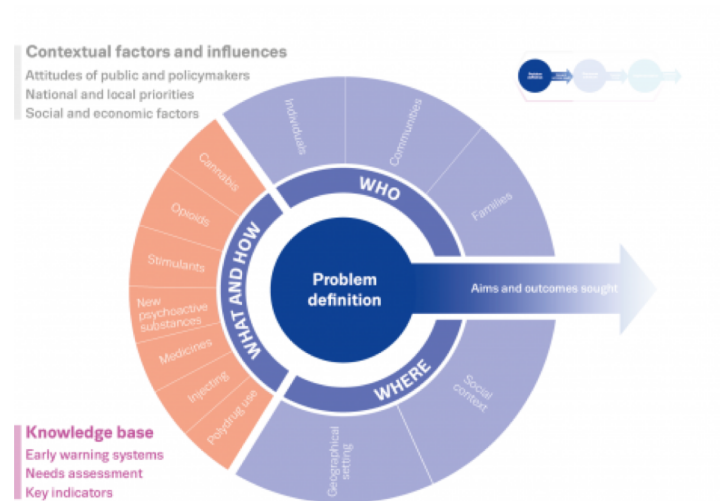

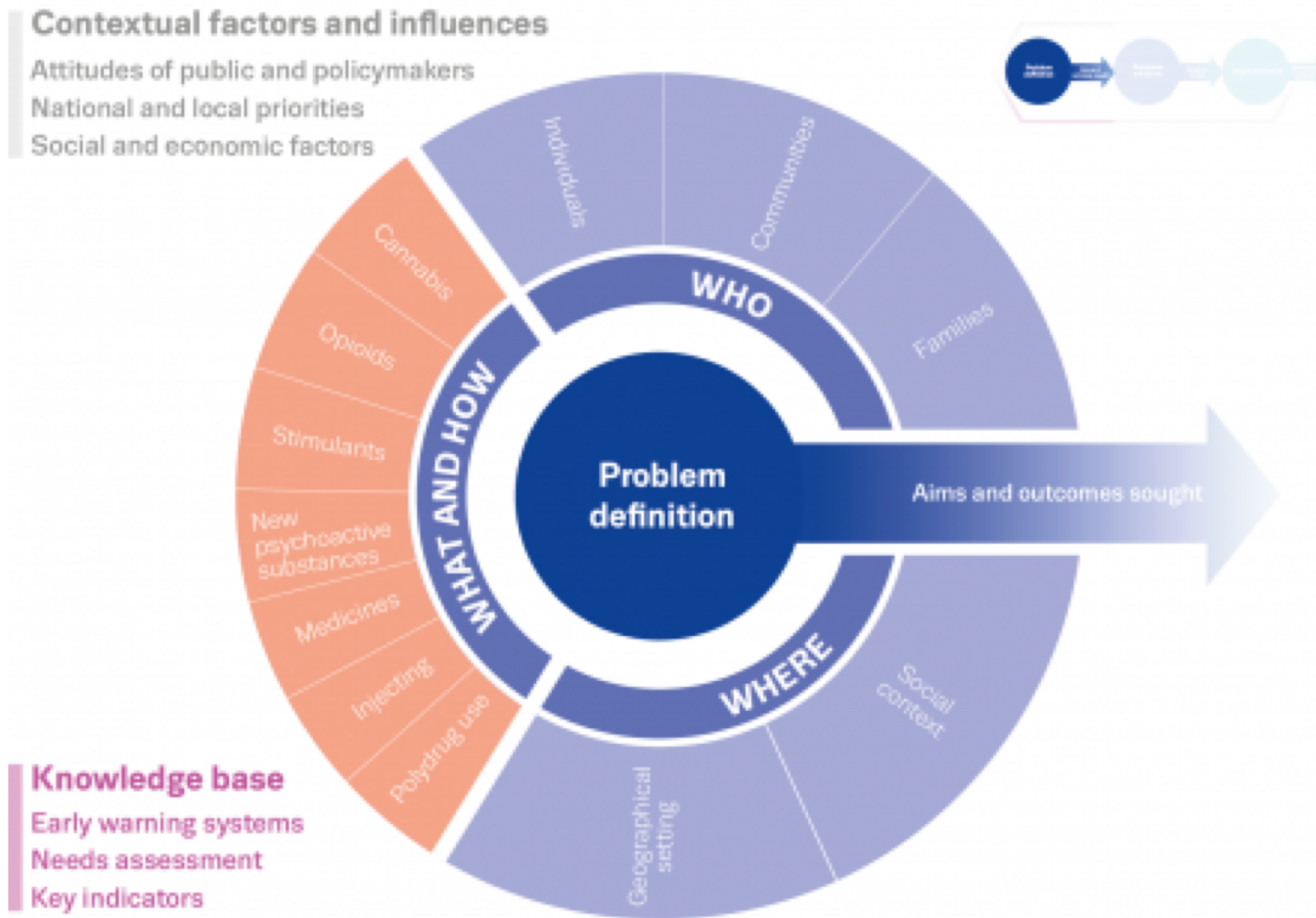
Example of a good choice for a model

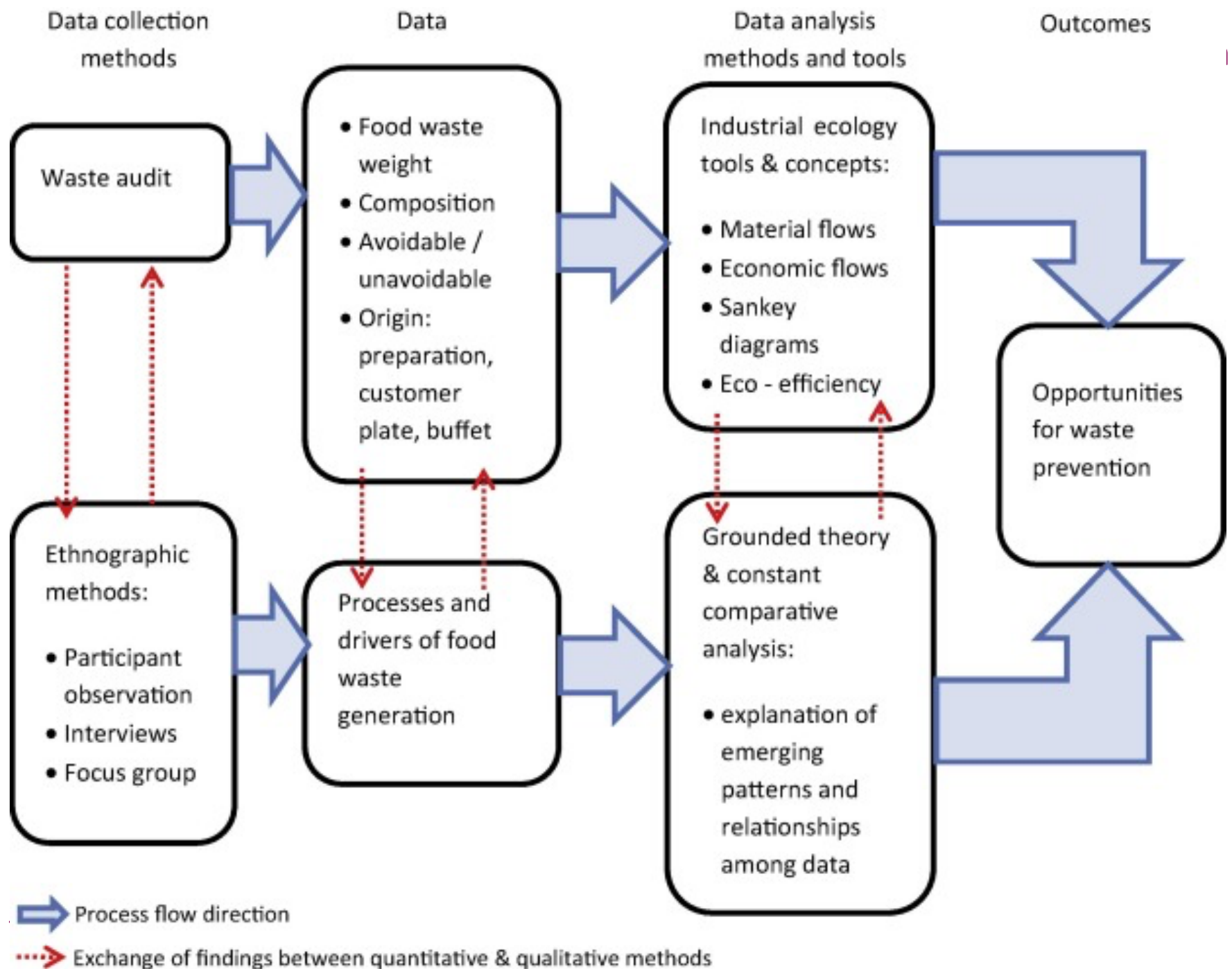

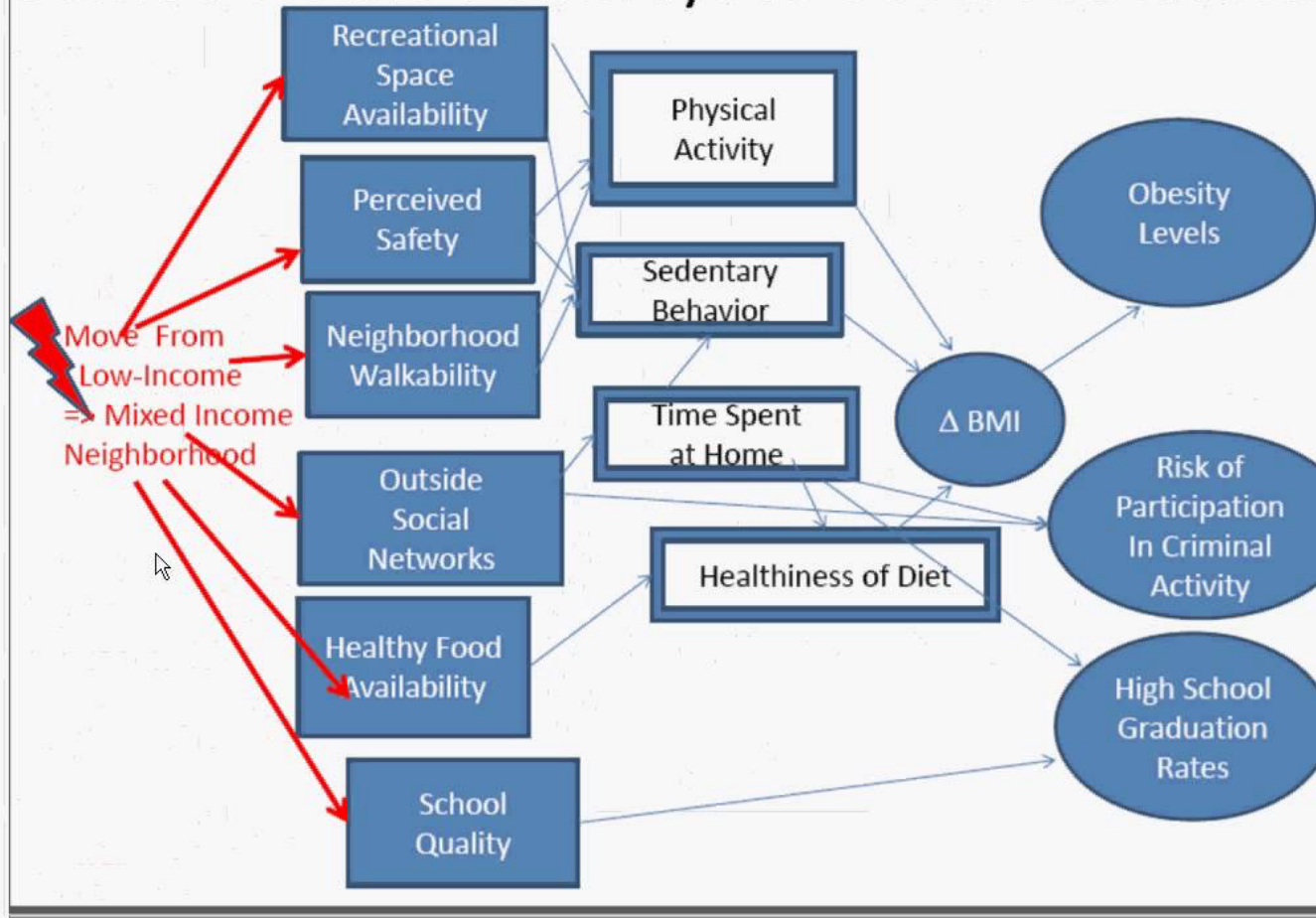

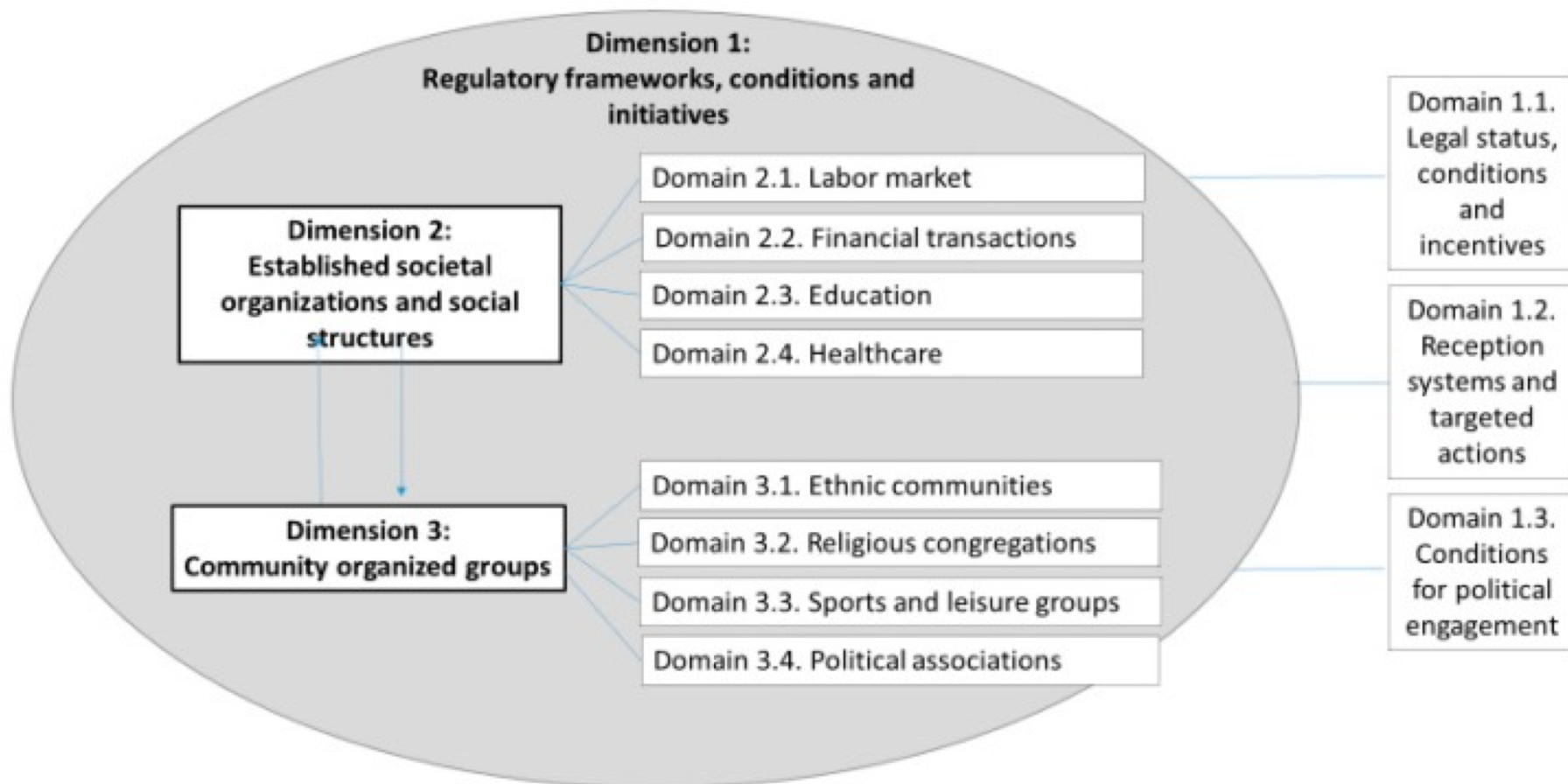

Some Possible Pathways to Observed Effects



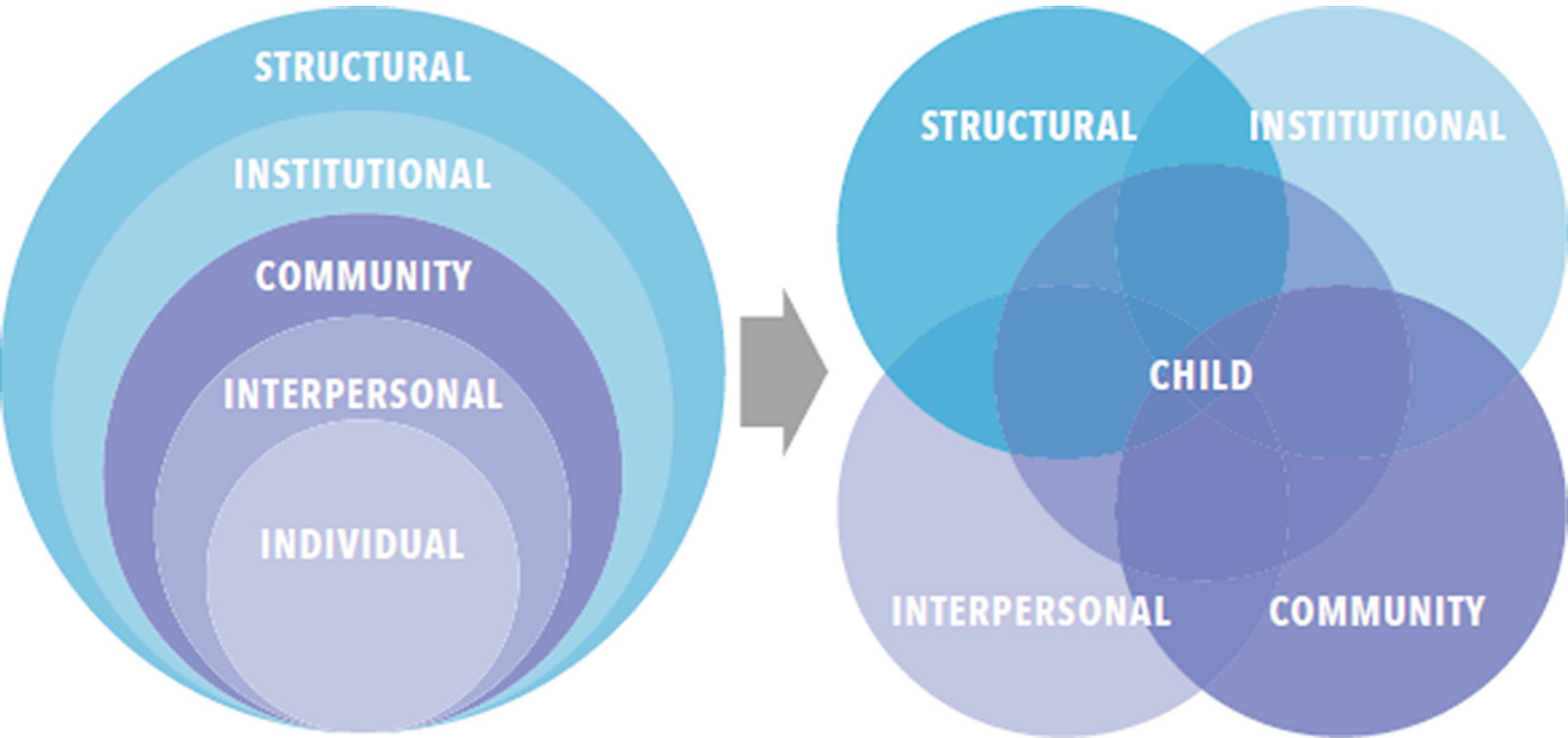

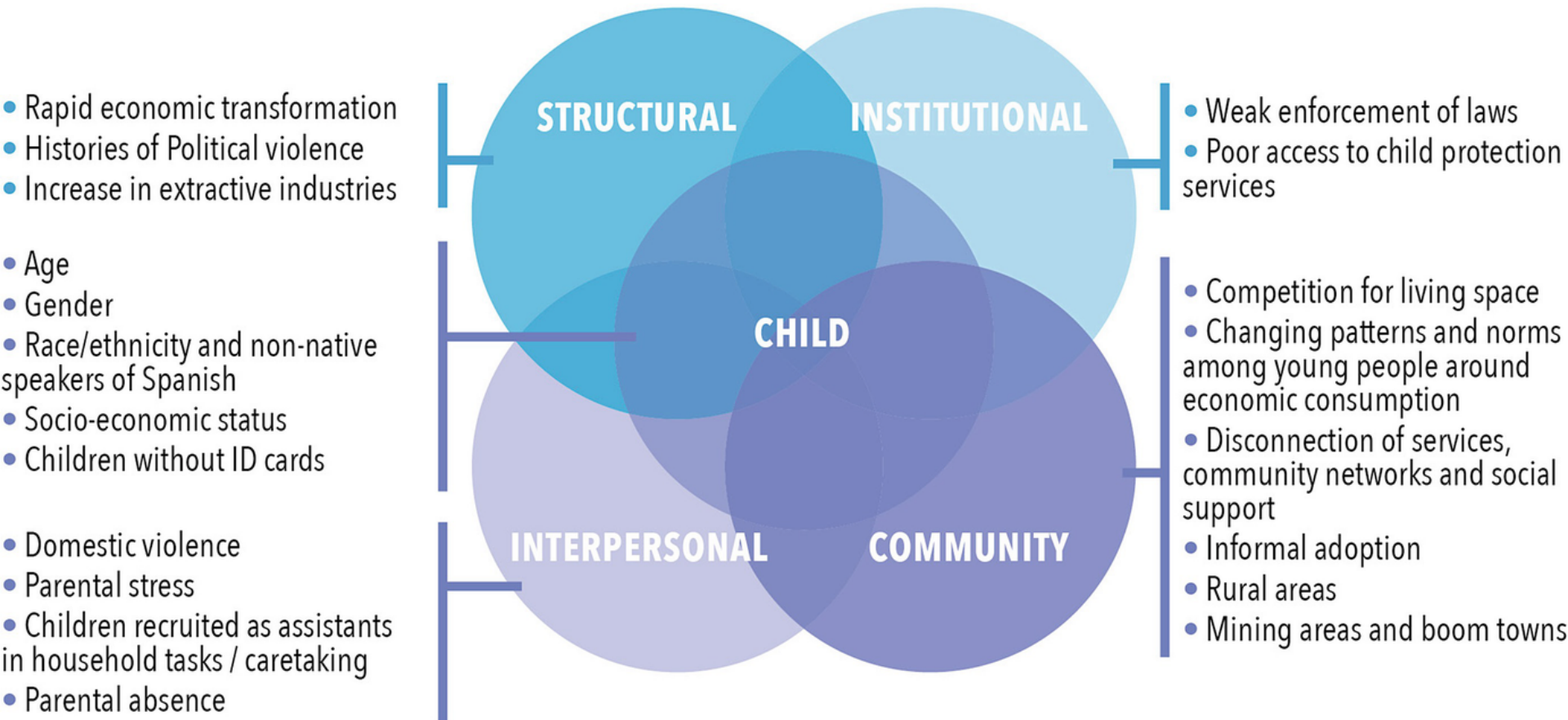

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KI Master Thesis Assessment Criteria

Pass with distinction:

Important theories/theoretical models are well described and explained.

Own results are also discussed in relation to the preferred theory.

Example from the literature...

Purpose: Young novice drivers continue to be overrepresented in fatalities and injuries arising from crashes...

Enhancing countermeasures requires a better understanding of the variables influencing risky driving. Psychosocial theory can improve our understanding of contributors to speeding, thereby informing countermeasure development and evaluation.

This paper reports an application of Akers' social learning theory (SLT), augmented by Gerrard and Gibbons' prototype/willingness model (PWM)...

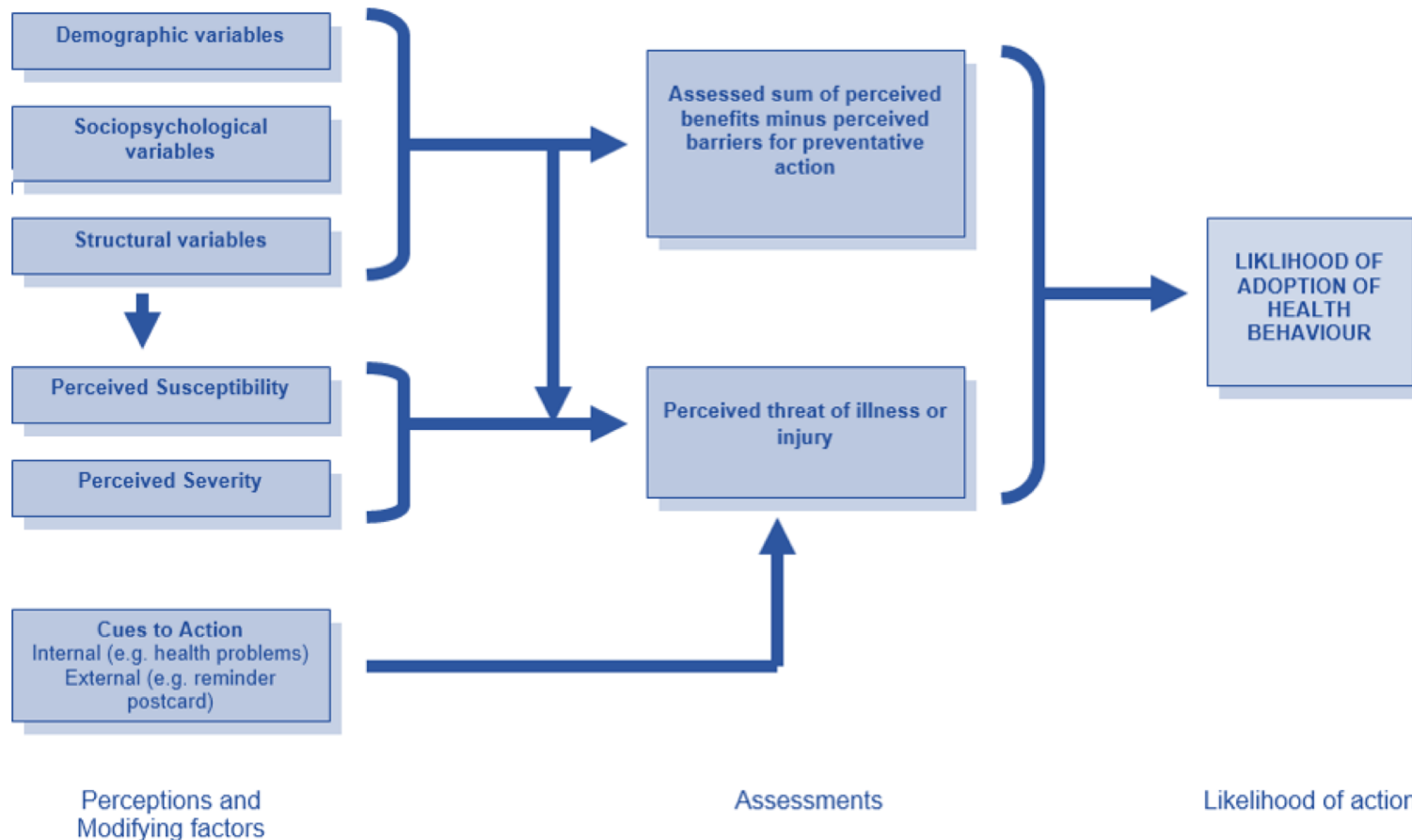
Example from the literature con't...

Abstract

Background: The No Germs on Me (NGoM) Social Marketing Campaign to promote handwashing with soap to reduce high rates of infection among children living in remote Australian Aboriginal communities has been ongoing since 2007. Recently three new television commercials were developed as an extension of the NGoM program. This paper reports on the mass media component of this program, trialling an evaluation design informed by the Theory of Planned Behaviour (TPB).

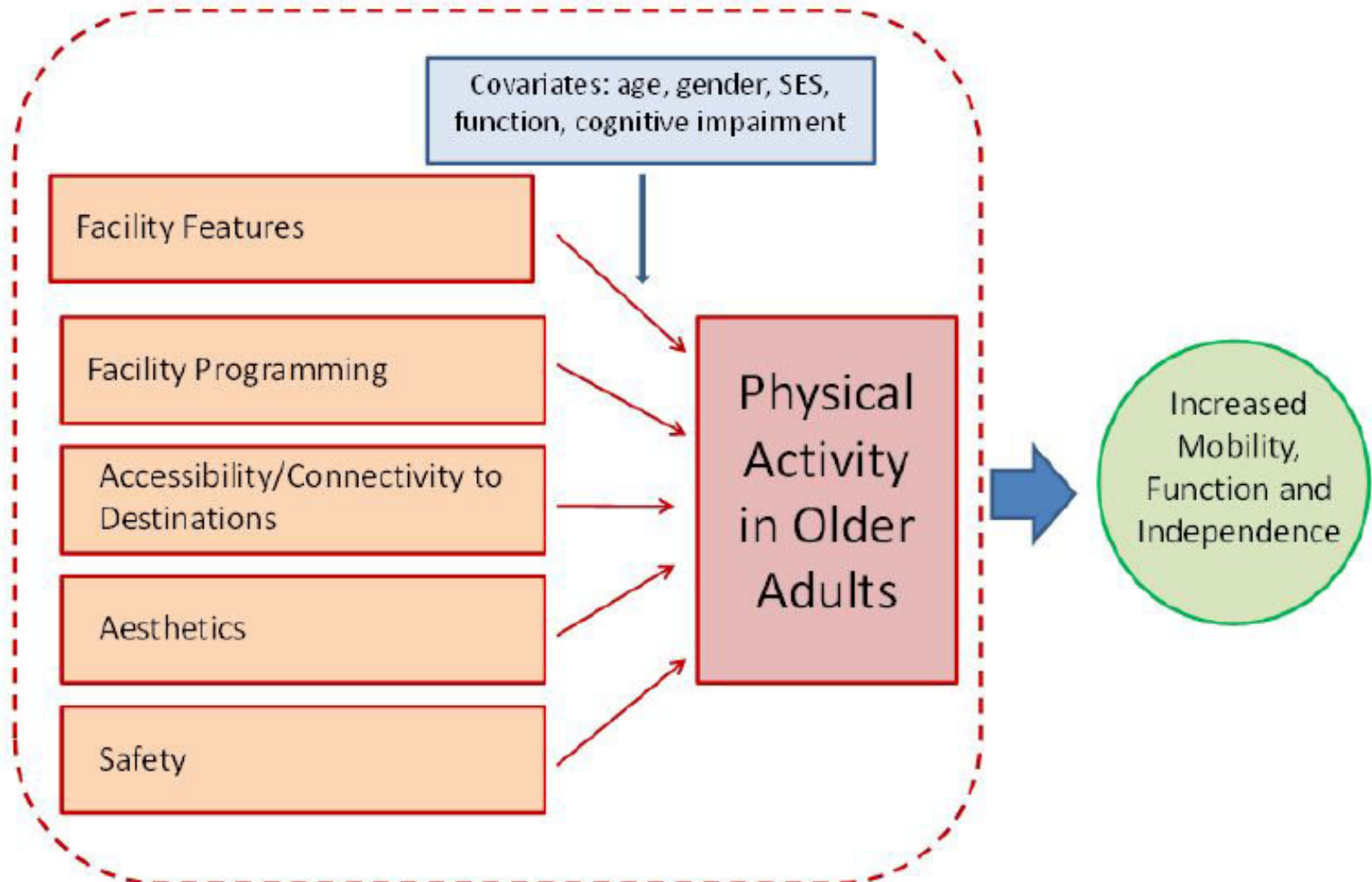


The Health Belief Model

(adapted from Becker and Rosenstock, 1984, and Stroebe, 2000)

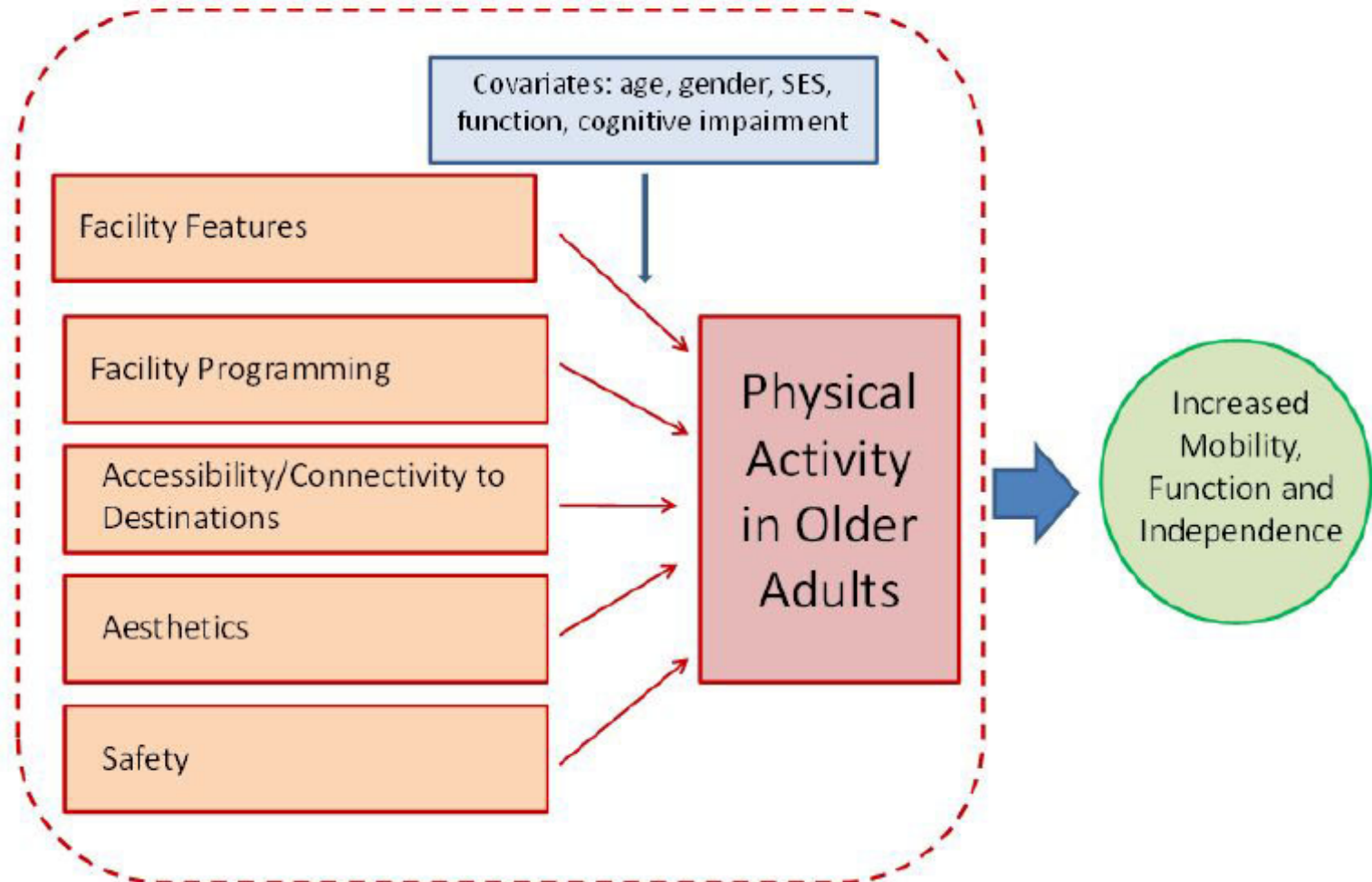
