




Figure 2: Analytics Steps, 2021.




Figure 3: SPSS Diagram regarding showing top 6 points agrees by 15 articles and websites.




Figure 4: SPSS Diagram regarding showing lower 6 points agrees by 15 articles and websites.




Figure 5: Creately Diagrams, 2021.
