- A clearly stated summary of the applicant's skills, experience, and credentials
- Relevant work history
- Appropriate terminology drawn from the advertised job description
- Writing that is brief and concrete

Provide Feedback on the following:

- Formatting
 - Uncluttered
 - Consistent
 - 1-2 pages
- Information
 - Organized from most-to-least current
 - Relevant
 - Clear
 - Brief
- Terminology
 - Correct
 - Current
 - Grammatical
- Grammar and Punctuation
 - Correct!
- Visual Perfection
 - No typing or formatting errors
 - Easy to read
 - Attractive design
