Lesson Plan

God and the Serpent DIAMANTE POEM

Objective: To read Genesis Ch3 and contrast God and the serpent; to write a diamante poem showing the differences between God and the serpent

Read Genesis 3. Have students break up into small groups and brainstorm the differences between God and the serpent. Each student will each have his/her own paper folded length-wise. The heading for the first column will be "GOD". The heading for the second column will be "THE SERPENT". This sheet will serve as a guide as they independently write their diamante poem. Distribute the Diamante Poem - God & The Serpent WORKSHEET. Explain the structure of the diamante poem. Read the sample diamante poem about Adam and Jesus at the bottom of the worksheet.
