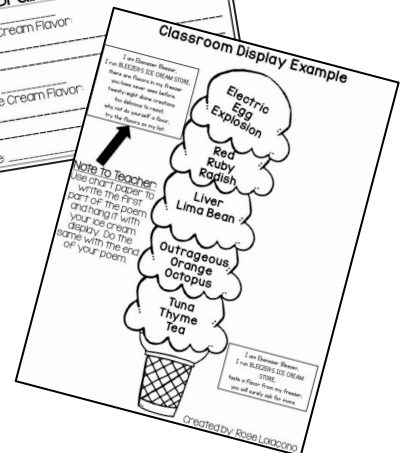
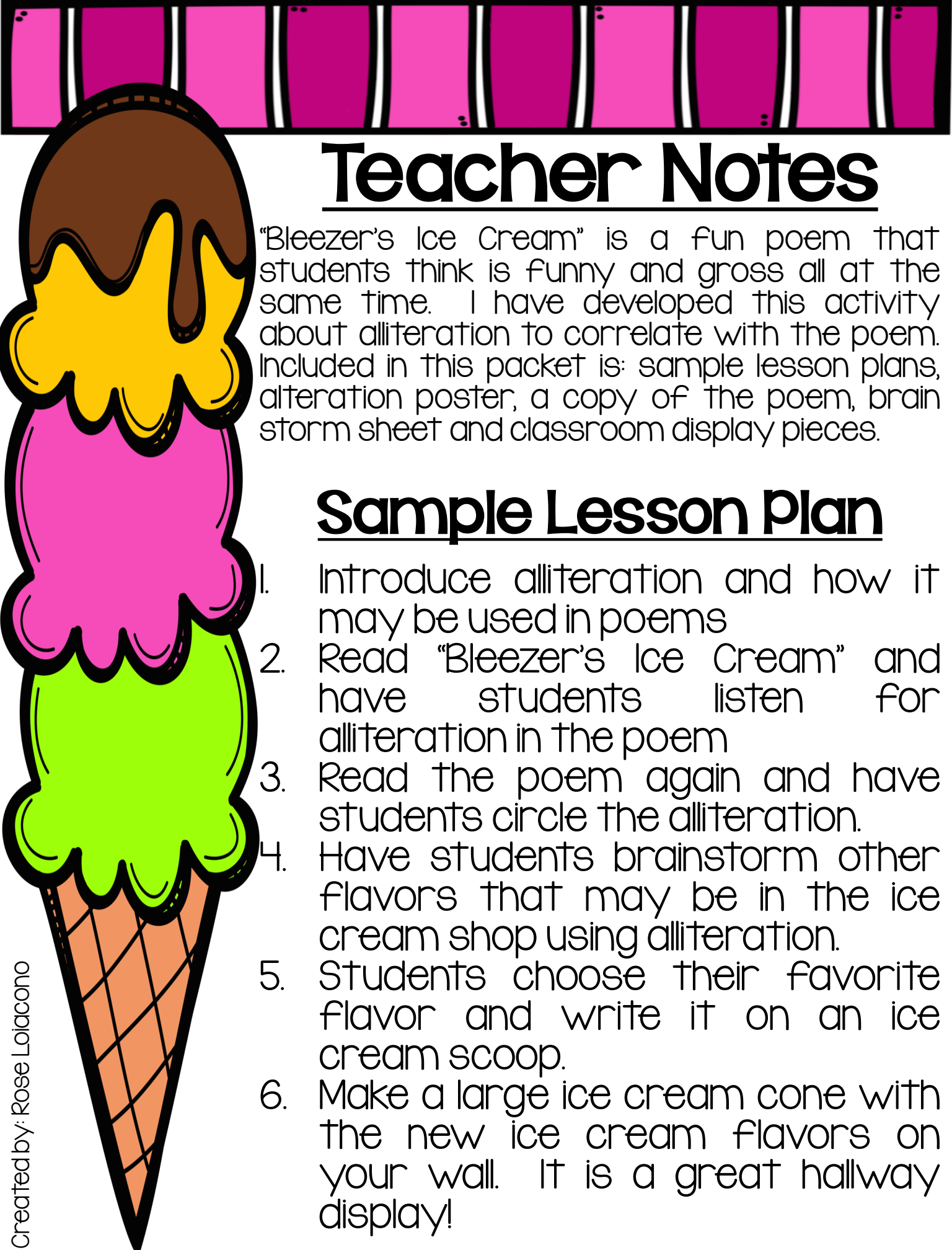


Alliteration Activity

Teacher Notes

"Bleezer's Ice Cream" is a fun poem that students think is funny and gross all at the same time. I have developed this activity about alliteration to correlate with the poem. Included in this packet is: sample lesson plans, alteration poster, a copy of the poem, brain storm sheet and classroom display pieces.

Sample Lesson Plan

1. Introduce alliteration and how it may be used in poems
2. Read "Bleezer's Ice Cream" and have students listen for alliteration in the poem
3. Read the poem again and have students circle the alliteration.
4. Have students brainstorm other flavors that may be in the ice cream shop using alliteration.
5. Students choose their favorite flavor and write it on an ice cream scoop.
6. Make a large ice cream cone with the new ice cream flavors on your wall. It is a great hallway display!

the beginning of a word

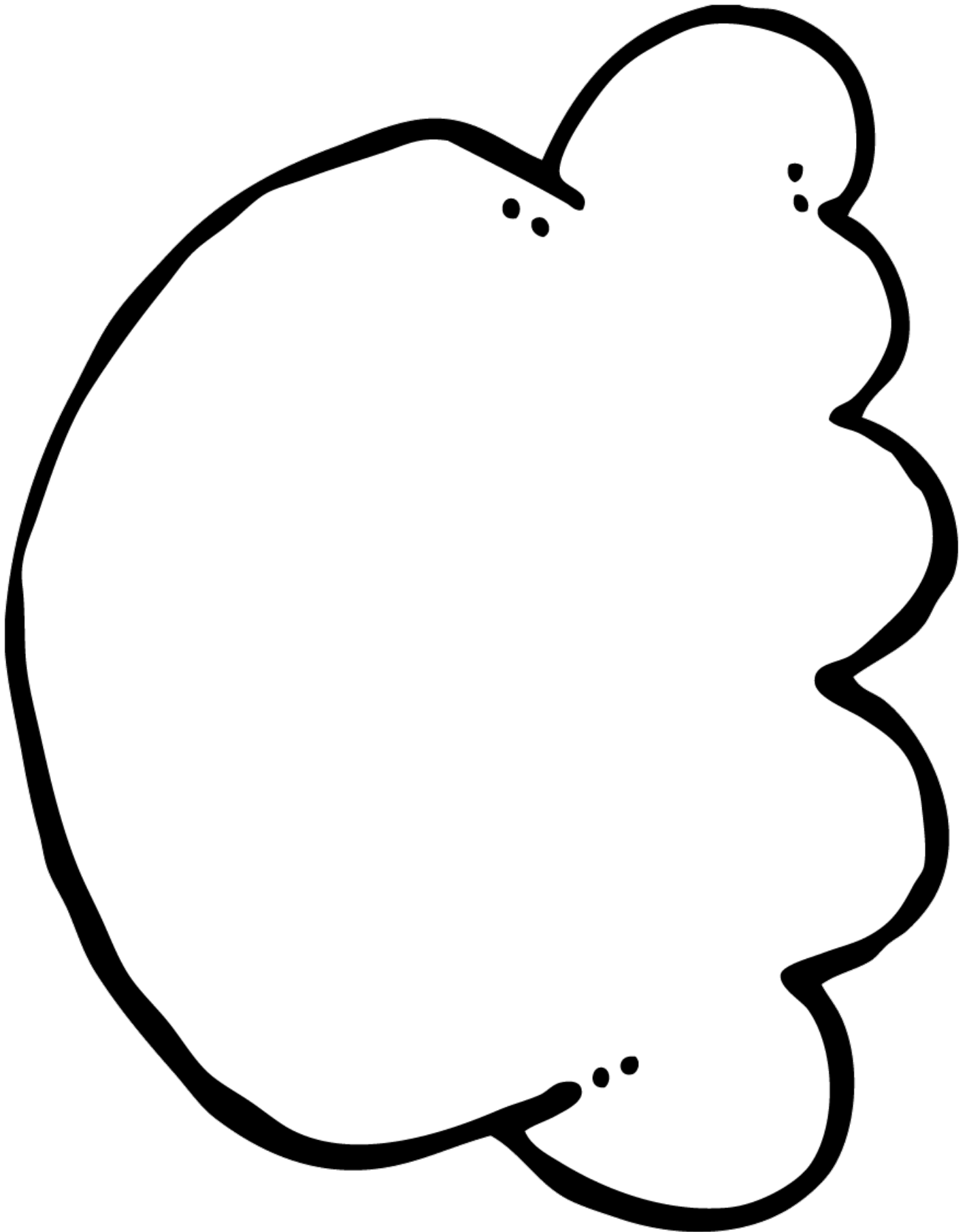

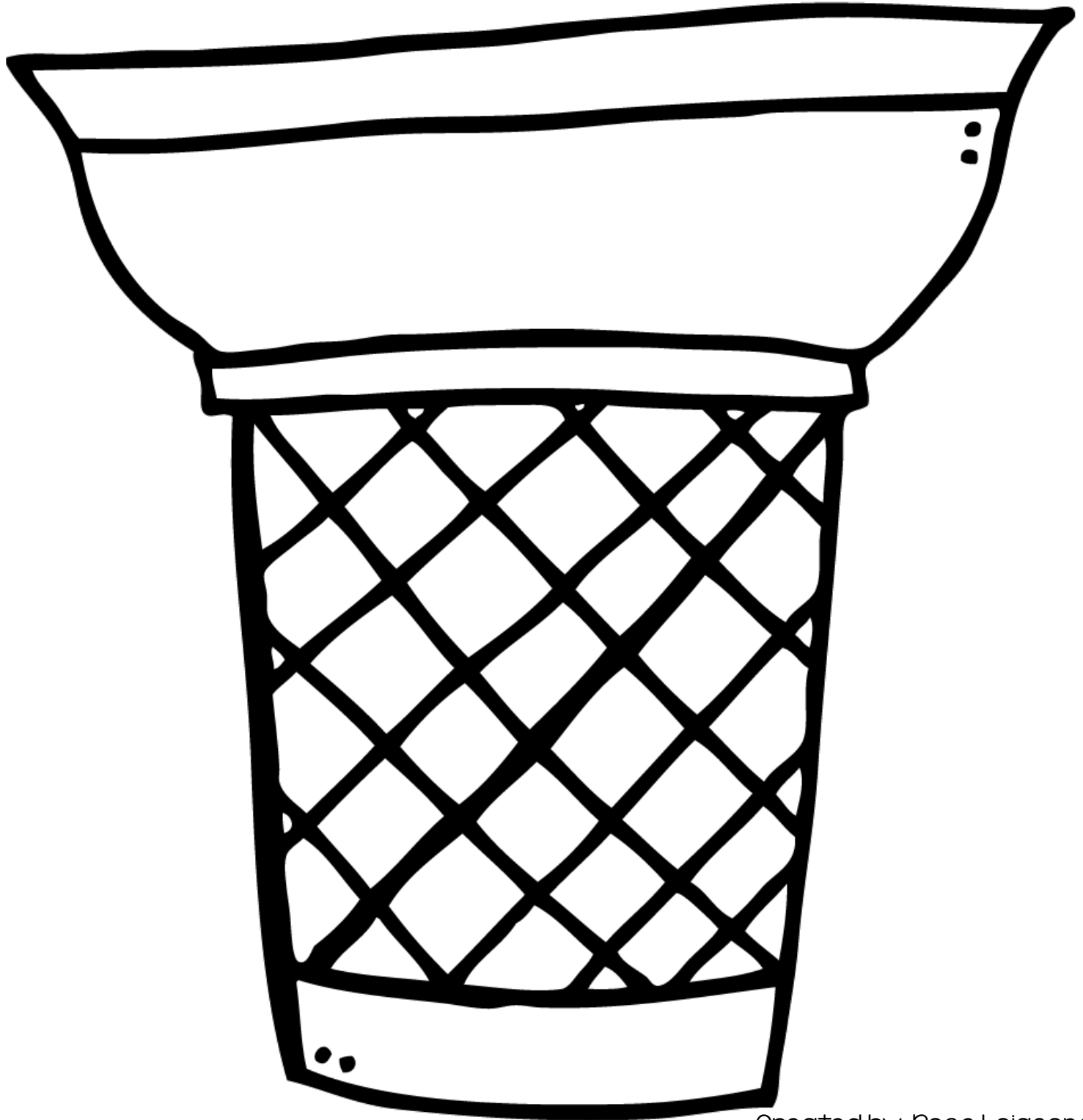

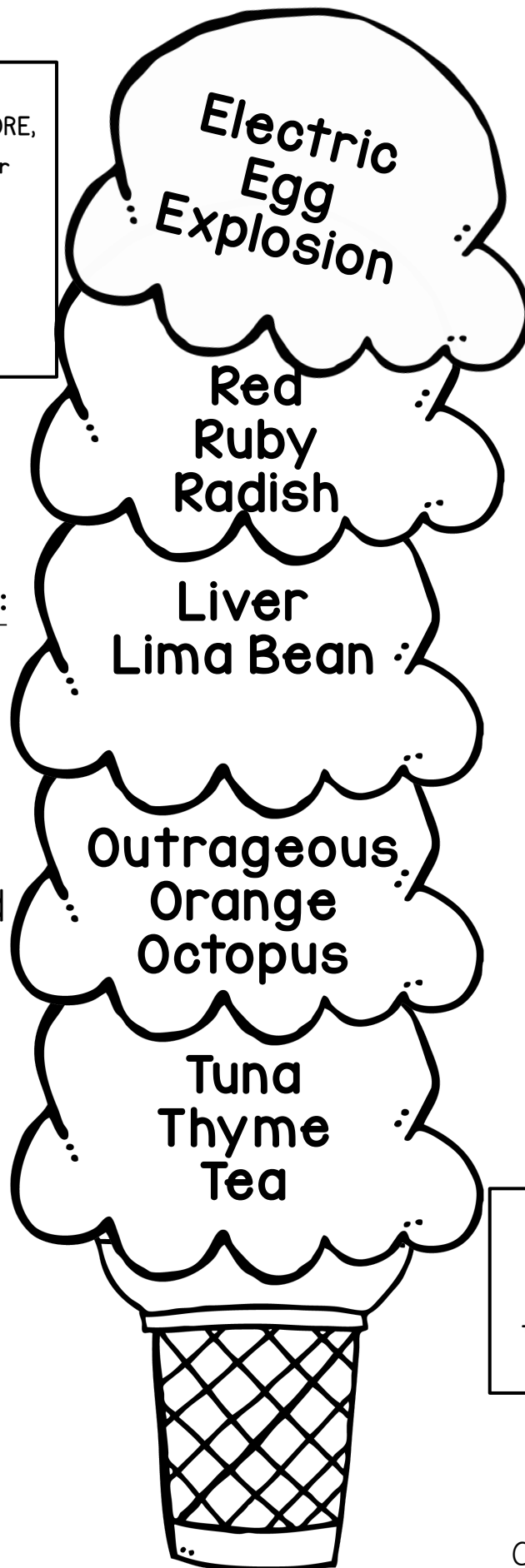


Classroom Display Example
