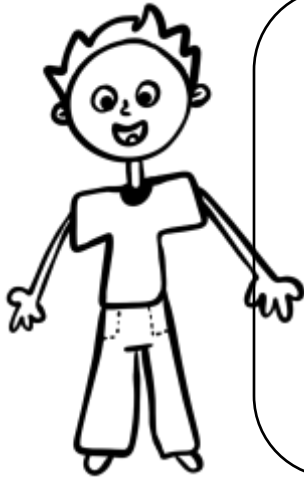


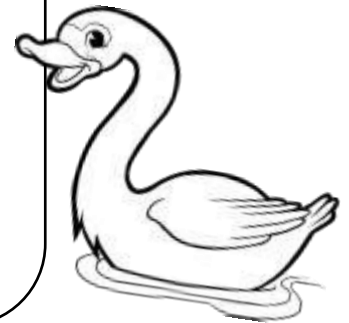
My Limerick Poem!
