Step 1 : Add 13 Table

↓

$120 \times 1 =$	12
$120 \times 2 =$	24
$120 \times 3 =$	36
$120 \times 4 =$	48

$120 \times 6 =$	72
$120 \times 7 =$	84
$120 \times 8 =$	96
$120 \times 9 =$	108
$120 \times 10 =$	120

Step 2 : Add 0 to the 12 Table

↓

$120 \times 1 =$	12	0
