

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

$$\begin{array}{rcl} \text{Maximum} & : & 5'(n) & = 0 \\ = & & (1)(2n^{2}+2n) - (4n+2)(n-1) = 0 \\ & & 2n^{2}+2n - (4n^{2}-4n+2n-2) = 0 \\ & & 2n^{2}+2n - 4n^{2}+4n - 2n - 2 = 0 \\ & & -2n^{2}+4n - 2 = 0 \\ & & & n^{2} - 2n + 1 = 0 \\ & & & (n-1)^{2} = 0 \\ & & = 2n + 1 \\ \end{array}$$

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
