

# Wedding Speech by Priest

---

## 1. Opening Blessing and Welcome

- Begin with a warm greeting to the congregation and a blessing.
- Acknowledge the sacredness of the occasion.

### Example:

"Dearly beloved, we are gathered here today in the sight of God, and in the presence of these witnesses, to join together [Bride's Name] and [Groom's Name] in holy matrimony. This is a sacred covenant, ordained by God, and a joyful celebration of their love."

## 2. Reflection on Marriage and Faith

**6. The Pronouncement**

- Declare the couple married in the eyes of God.

**Example:**

"By the authority vested in me, and as a servant of God, I now pronounce you husband and wife. What God has joined together, let no one separate. You may now share your first kiss as a married couple."

(Pause for the kiss and applause.)

**7. Closing Blessing**

- Offer a final prayer or blessing over the couple.

**Example:**

"Let us bow our heads in prayer. Heavenly Father, we ask Your blessing upon [Bride's Name] and [Groom's Name]. Fill their hearts with love, their home with peace, and their life with joy. May they walk together in faith, guided by Your wisdom and grace. Amen."
